- c) Winners of AANR regional scholarships will be considered for additional funds and
- d) Be a member or have a parent, grandparent, or guardian who is one of the following:
 - a. AANR member
 - b. A subscriber to the NEF Newsletter
 - c. A patron of the NEF Library
 - d. Have a parent, grandparent or guardian who receives the NEF Newsletter.

What are the applicant's responsibilities?

- a. Complete an application form.
- b. Complete the essay questions.
- c. Obtain two (2) letters of recommendation (see below).
- d. Send us your latest transcript. So, get us a transcript of your secondary education if you are enrolling for your first year of college/technical/vocational school or a transcript of your current post-secondary school if you have left high school. If you are not currently enrolled, please ask that the transcript from the last school you attended be sent to us.
- e. All the above items must be sent **on or before May 1**st **of the application year** to <u>scholarships@aanr-ef.com</u>.

What letters of recommendation are needed?

- a. A letter of academic recommendation from a teacher, school counselor, or administrator.
- b. A letter of personal recommendation from a person in authority in the applicant's local community (employer, volunteer organization, etc).

What is the review process?

The AANR-EF Scholarship Committee will review all completed applications by June 15 for the current calendar year using only the information provided by the applicant. All applicants will be notified by July 1 of the committee's decision.


