Please note: OSHA Outreach courses are limited to students in OSHA's jurisdiction. Students taking training outside the United States are not eligible to receive OSHA cards. For international employers, we offer an equivalent training — Advanced Safety Orientation. These suites are designed for global audiences and are similar to the OSHA Outreach courses but do not extend the Department of Labor OSHA cards.

OSHA 10 General Industry:

The OSHA 10 General Industry training course includes a cross section of essential topics from OSHA Standards for General Industry, 29 CFR 1910. All trainees have 24/7 access to the courses and customer service by phone or email.

OSHA 10 and OSHA 30 Construction Industry:

The OSHA 10 and OSHA 30 Construction Industry training courses include a cross section of essential topics from OSHA Standards for Construction, 29 CFR 1926. All trainees have 24/7 access to the courses and customer service by phone or email. The OSHA 10 Construction Industry training course is available in Spanish in addition to English. UL also offers actively proctored OSHA 10 and OSHA 30 Construction Industry training courses, as required by NYC LL 196.

OSHA 10 High-Tech/Semiconductor Industry:

Workers in semiconductor and related high-tech industries face unique hazards including pyrophoric, flammable, toxic and corrosive gases and liquids. Information about these hazards are commonly missing from mainstream training courses. For these reasons, SESHA and UL collaborated in the creation of a high-tech/semiconductor industry-specific version of the 10-hour OSHA Outreach Training for General Industry. All trainees have 24/7 access to the courses and customer service by phone or email.
