Zenith Books was the last paperback imprint to be issued by Martin Goodman, still a few years away from the resurgence of his comic book line, the silver-age Marvel Comics. Goodman's previous paperback imprint, **Lion Books**, had been caught in the distribution implosion that resulted from the dissolution of The American News Company. The last Lion Books appeared in April 1957; the imprint was suspended and their existing backlist, as well as their unissued inventory, was sold off to other publishers. Goodman wasted little time setting up the new publishing company; the first Zenith Books hit the newsstands fifteen months later.

As discussed in the separate **Lion Books** index, at least five of the left-over Lion Books were eventually published as Zenith Books (#s 2, 5, 6, 10 and 13, with #12 an additional possibility.) In addition, Damon Knight has described how his SF novel, *The People Maker*, was originally contracted with Lion Books, but by the time it was turned in, the contract had been acquired by Zenith Books.¹

The publication address of Zenith Books raises several questions about its ownership and management. Rockville Center was the publication address of a separate set of companies, usually referred to as Humorama, whose original ownership is uncertain, that was run by Martin Goodman's brother, Abraham. That Martin Goodman was the owner of Zenith Books, Inc. is readily demonstrable by the fact that it was one of the companies that he sold to [Cadence Industries] in 1968. The Humorama companies, however, were not part of that sale and eventually came under the direct ownership of Abraham Goodman. The Rockville Center address for Zenith Books suggests that Abraham Goodman may actually have been running it, even if his brother still owned it. It also begs the question as to who Zenith's distributor was. **Lion Books** folded when IND, Goodman's new distributor, declined to carry them. Humorama's distributor is unknown; **Zenith Books** may have been operated by Humorama for their access to a different distributor.

All Zenith Books contain a month of publication and even though I do not have that information for all titles, a pattern of issuance can be clearly inferred. Books were issued at the rate of two per month, from July 1958 to June 1960, with none being dated August 1958 or May 1960. This is not a very aggressive publishing schedule compared to other mass-market publishers; even Lion Books was publishing 6 to 8 books a month at the time it died. It may be significant that there are no mail-order ads, or any other kind of book listings, in any of the Zenith Books seen. This suggests that Zenith was aiming exclusively for newsstand distribution and eschewing any alternative avenues of distribution. This strategy would discourage going back to press for additional printings and, as far as I know, there is no evidence that any Zenith Books had multiple printings.

The logo displayed above was discontinued with the September 1959 releases; number 26 was the last book to carry it.

The annotation of the publication dates, as given in the Catalog of Copyright Entries, presents some problems. It appears that in the beginning Zenith Books were published in the month after the month given in the books themselves. The later books have publication dates one month *before* the date given in the books, which makes more sense. If the earlier publication dates are correct, they would have to have issued six books in October 1959 to accomplish the apparent turnaround. This seems unlikely. I suspect that the clerical person assigned to fill out the Copyright registration forms was putting down incorrect dates on those early registrations (perhaps the application dates), and that eventually someone wised up and started doing them correctly.

Of the 44 books issued under this imprint, 25 were reprints and 19 were "originals." By genre, the books break down as follows: 16 mystery or crime novels, 11 love novels, 5 non-fiction, 2 each of historical novels, science fiction novels, war novels and cartoon books, 1 western and 3 miscellaneous titles.

Nine of the love novels were reprints of books that had originally been issued by already defunct digest-size imprints earlier in the decade. There were a lot of such reprints in the 1960s but this marked the first time that any had been reissued by a mass-market publisher.

All of the covers had some form of illustration, although there are, sadly, no art credits in any of the books. Three books had photographic covers; the two cartoon collections had collages of cartoons on the front and back covers. The other 39 books had painted covers, very few of which are signed. All 44 of the covers are displayed on the Bookscans website. In an effort to identify as many of the cartoonists as possible, scans of several "unreadable" signatures are included.

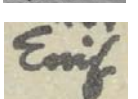

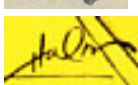
