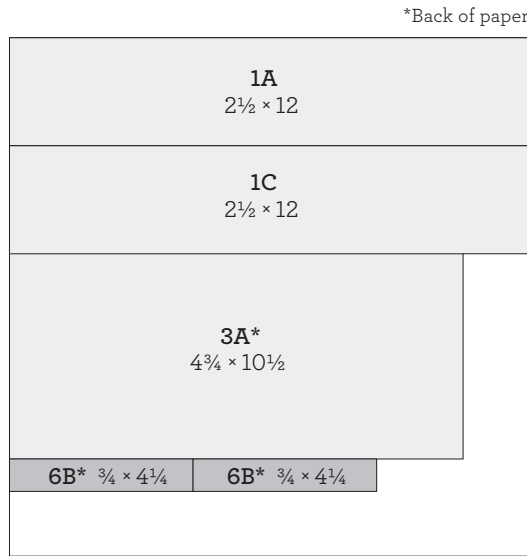


Penelope

This workshop guide includes patterns, photos, tips, and cutting diagrams to walk you through creating all four Penelope Workshops Your Way™ layouts. At the end of this guide, you will find instructions for creating the additional cardmaking project. As you cut the paper, sort the pieces as indicated in the diagrams, creating a stack for each of the layouts and the cards. Make certain to save all zip strips from the B&T Duos™, as they will be used in the layouts and additional project.

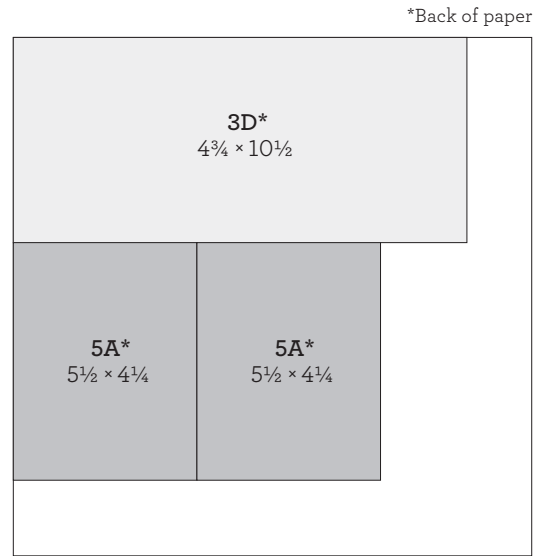

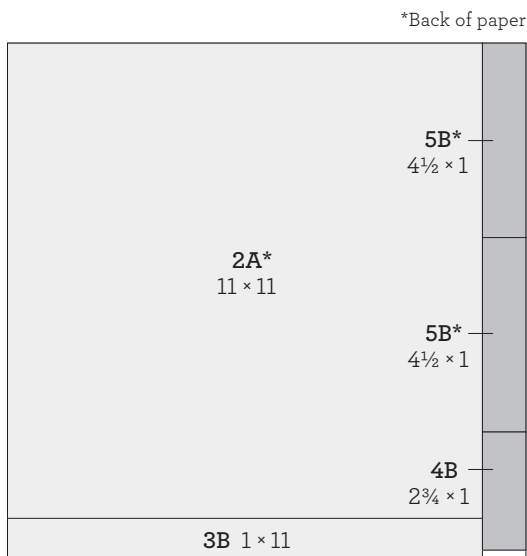

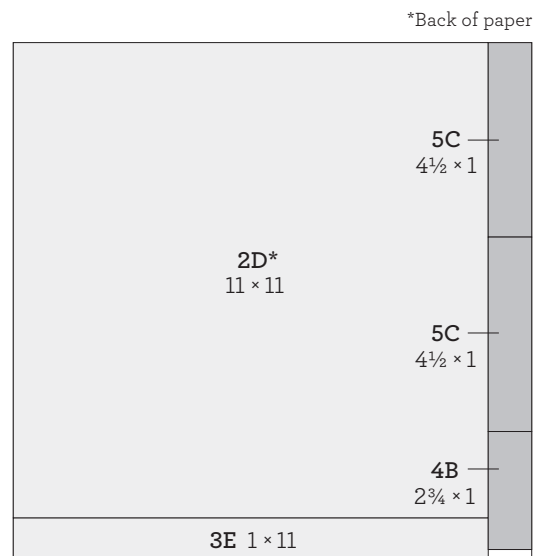

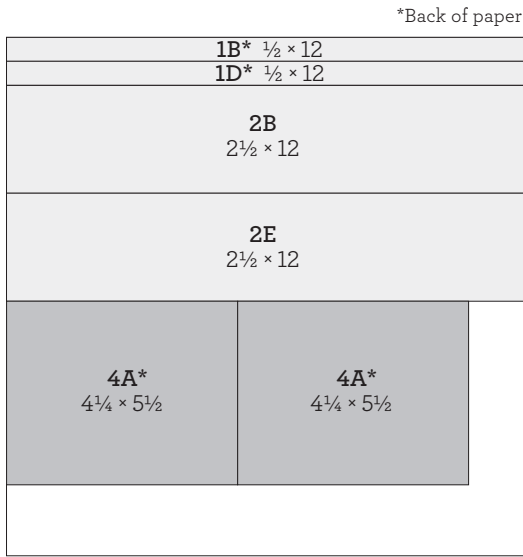

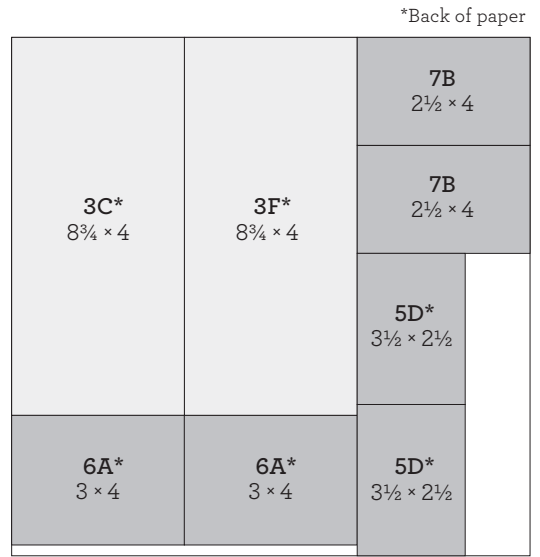

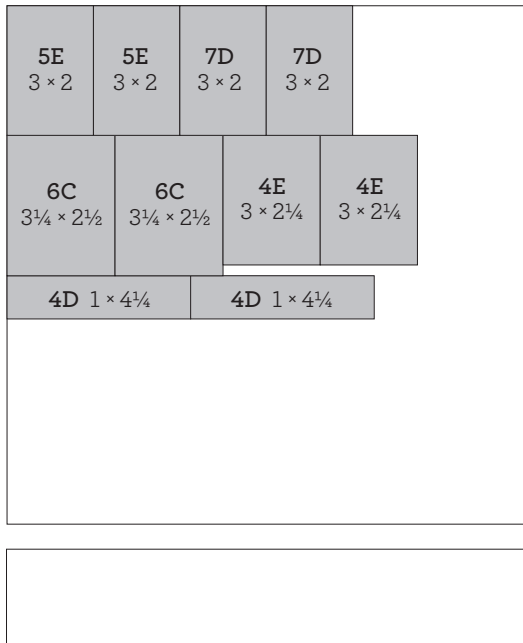

7C: 3" × ½" (cut 2)



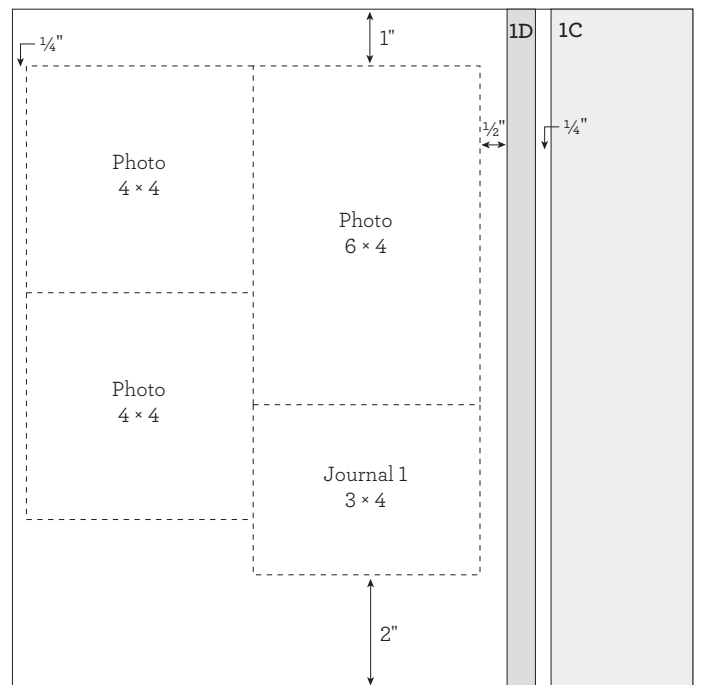
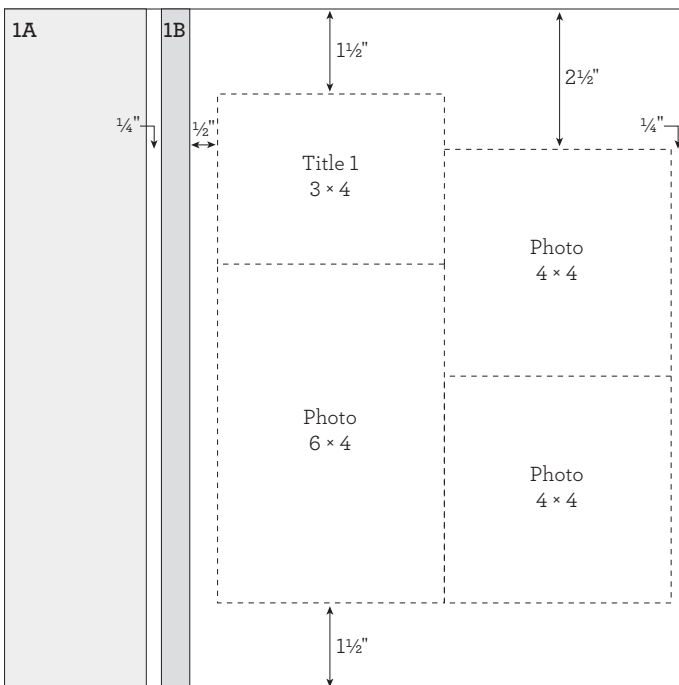
Yellow Woodgrain Zip Strip

12" x 12" Spring Is Here Layout

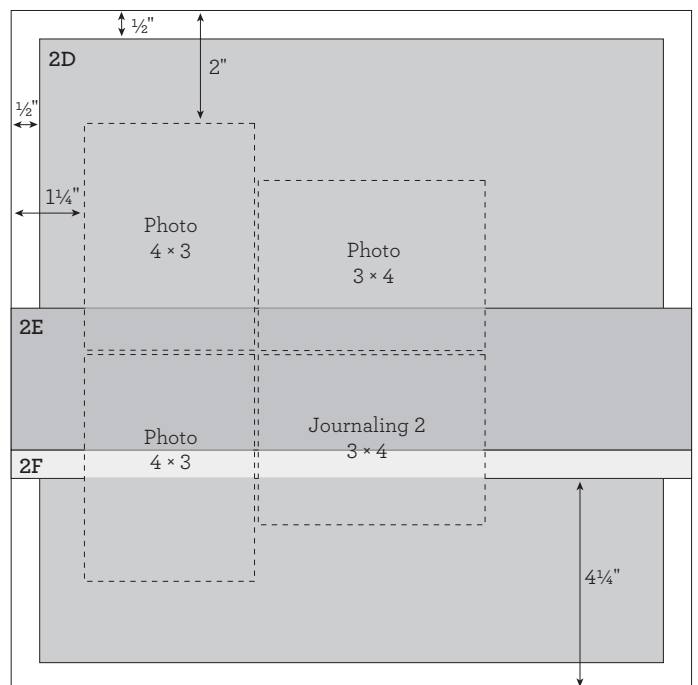
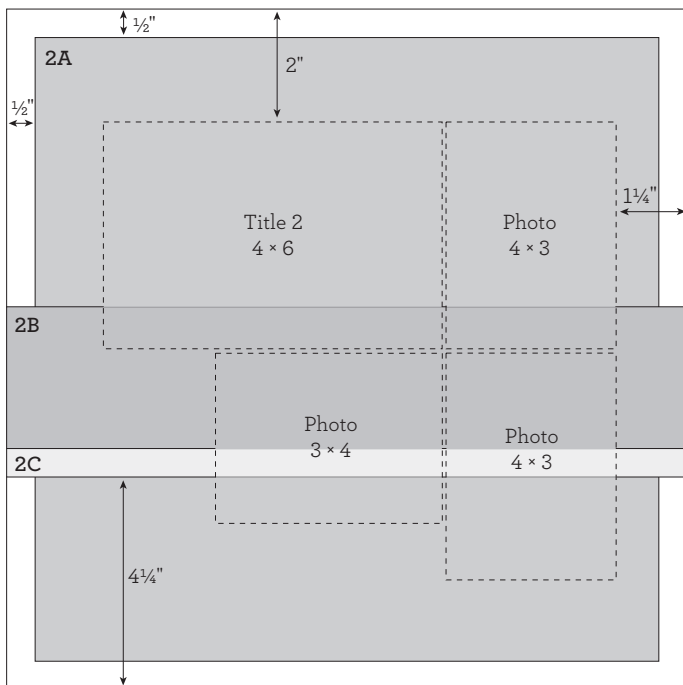
*Please note: paper orientation may not match photo



TIPS

- Use multi-colored dot B&T paper as page bases
- Attach Thistle washi tape to base page along right edge of 1A and along left edge of 1C in 1/4" gap
- Use 3" x 4" Picture My Life™ bird card as title 1; add "spring" and "is here" Penelope Complements to complete title
- Attach Pear washi tape directly above photo on right side of title; cluster Penelope Complements, and Playful Puffies on top right corner of title 1
- Use 3" x 4" Picture My Life flower card as journaling 1; add journaling, and arrange Penelope Complements and Playful Puffies on journaling 1 as desired
- Attach Pear washi tape directly below photo on left side of journaling; cluster Penelope Complements and Playful Puffies by tape as desired.
- Add Penelope Complements arrows in-between 4" x 4" photos

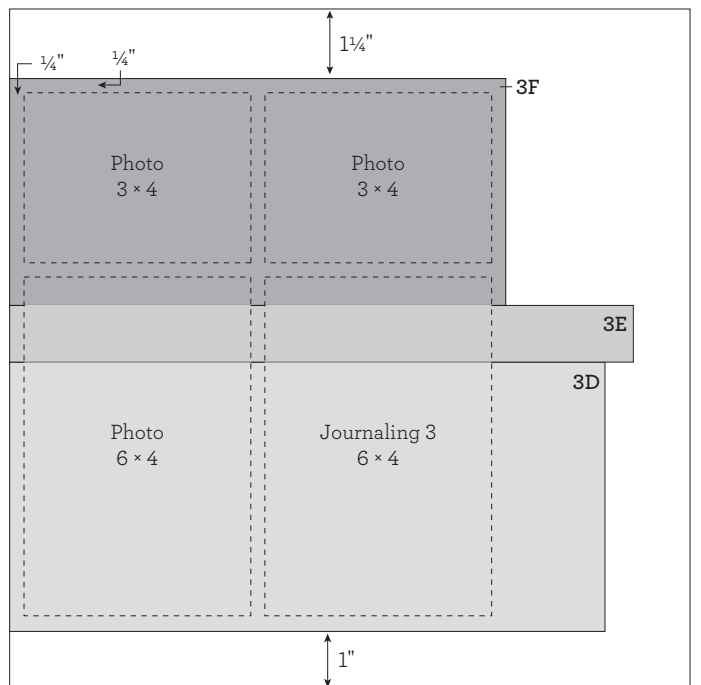
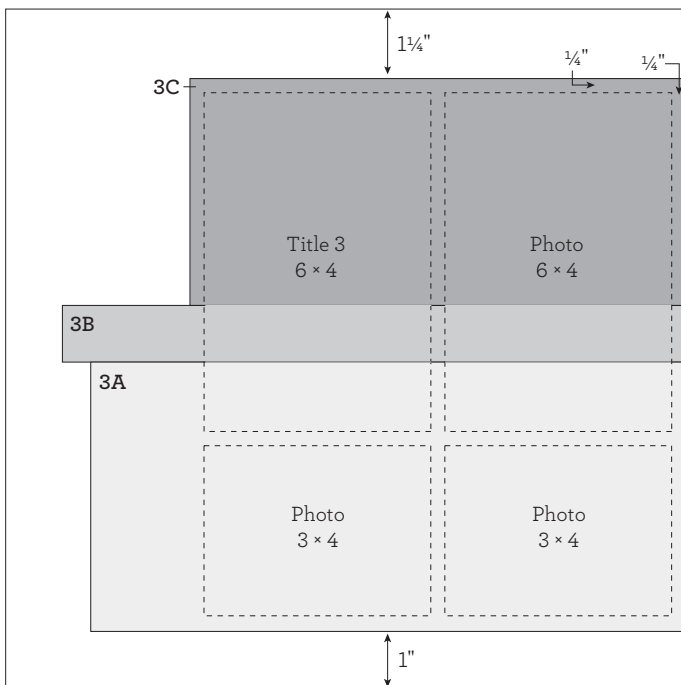
12" x 12" Make Today Fun Layout



TIPS

- Use Crystal Blue dot B&T paper as page bases
- Use polka dot zip strips to create 2C and 2F
- Place Pixie washi tape above 2B and 2E
- Attach 3" x 1/2" Honey flowers zip strip to left edge of 3" x 4" photo on left page
- Use 4" x 6" "Make Today Fun" Picture My Life™ card as title 2; cluster Penelope Compliments and Playful Puffies around title 2 as desired
- Use 3" x 4" Picture My Life "So Many Reasons" card as journaling 2; attach "HAPPINESS" sticker directly below journaling card and embellish as desired
- Attach 1/2" x 4" Honey flowers zip strip above 3" x 4" photo on right page
- Place three pennants on top right corner of 2D
- Add journaling and additional embellishments as desired

12" × 12" All Smiles Layout



TIPS

- Use White Daisy Cardstock as page bases
- Place Pixie and Thistle washi tape diagonally on top left corner of left page and top right corner of right page
- Use 6" × 4" Picture My Life™ birds on a wire card as title 3; add "all" and "SMILES" Penelope Complements to complete title, and add additional embellishments as desired
- Cluster Penelope Complements and Playful Puffies on top left corner of 3F
- Use 6" × 4" Picture My Life frog journaling card for journaling 3
- Add three pennants directly below 3E to right of journaling 3
- Place "hello" die-cut and "happy" sticker on journaling 3; arrange Penelope Complements and Playful Puffies around and on journaling 3 as desired
- Add journaling and additional embellishments as desired

Additional Cardmaking Project

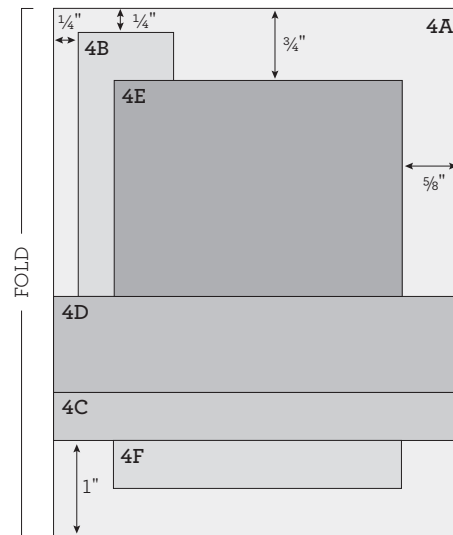
To create the additional cardmaking project, you will need to purchase the following supplies if you do not already have them:

MATERIALS

- C1638 My Acrylix® Spring Critters
- Z3146 Watercolor Paper
- 44751 Archival Black Exclusive Inks™ Pad
- Z3132 Watercolor Paints
- Z3188 Paintbrush Set
- Z3207 Spring Critters Thin Cuts
- Z2027 Mini Stapler
- Z2060 Thin 3-D Foam Tape
- X254 White Cards & Envelopes Value Pack

Then follow the patterns and photos below to create your cards. Cut all Thin Cuts shapes before assembling cards. You can cut multiple shapes using the Thin Cuts by layering 2-3 sheets of paper together and running them through your die-cutting machine multiple times.

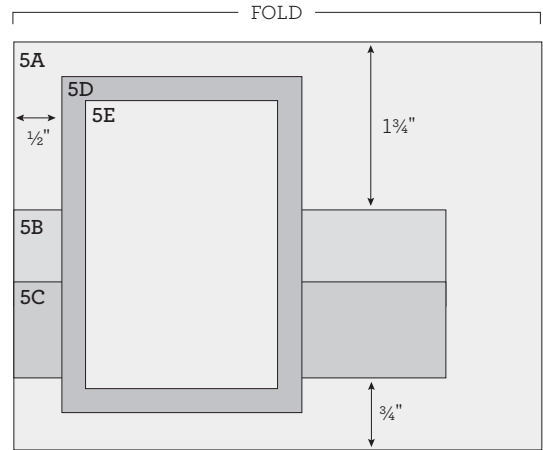
5½" × 4¼" You're the Best Card



TIPS

- Using blue watercolor paint, create sky on 4E; using green paint, paint grass sprigs on 4D
- Using Spring Critters Thin Cuts, cut bird image from watercolor paper; stamp corresponding image and desired sentiment on shape using Archival Black ink, and paint image using watercolors
- Embellish card using Playful Puffies and mini staples as desired

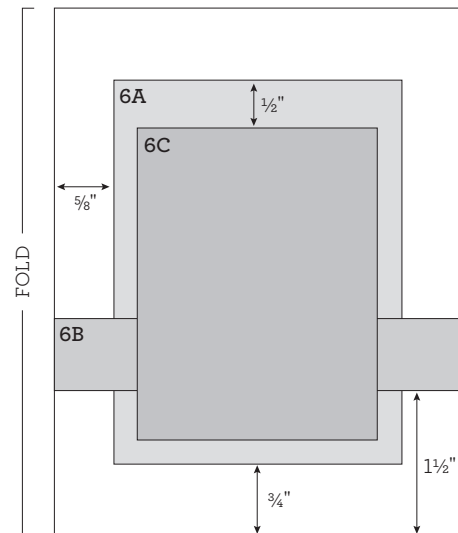
4¼" × 5½" How You Doin'? Card



TIPS

- Dovetail right ends of 5B and 5C; attach 5B at a slight angle layered underneath 5C
- Using blue and green watercolor paints, create sky and grass background on 5E
- Using Spring Critters Thin Cuts, cut frog image from watercolor paper; stamp corresponding image and desired sentiment on shape using Archival Black ink, and paint image using watercolors
- Embellish card using Playful Puffies and mini staples as desired

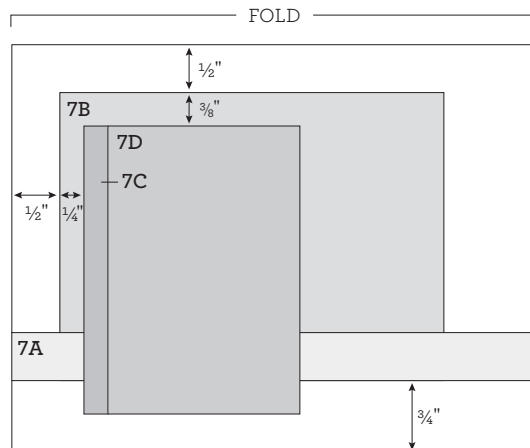
5½" × 4¼" Birthday Wishes Card



TIPS

- Using pink watercolor paint, paint across 6C, adding paint splatters as desired
- Using Spring Critters Thin Cuts, cut fox image from watercolor paper; stamp corresponding image and desired sentiment on shape using Archival Black ink, and paint image using watercolors
- Attach Thistle washi tape directly below 6B
- Embellish card using Playful Puffies and mini staples as desired

4¼" × 5½" Happy Easter Card



TIPS

- Using blue watercolor paint, create background on 7D; add Pear washi tape across bottom for grass
- Using Spring Critters Thin Cuts, cut bunny image from watercolor paper; stamp corresponding image and desired sentiment onto shape using Archival Black ink, and paint image using watercolors
- Embellish card using Playful Puffies and mini staples as desired
