Flashing Lights | EMS Update Part 2 Hits Today, 7 New Languages Added, Q3 Roadmap Announced

[Flashing Lights](#), the increasingly popular 10 player multiplayer police, fire and EMS simulator game, today receives a substantial update, including the addition of 7 new languages. Today also marks the reveal of the next three months of Early Access updates, all the while players can pick up the game at 25% off in the Steam Summer Sale.

Today's update introduces the ability for police officers to call for medical support when injured in the line of duty. When playing in multiplayer, this feature will send an alert to any EMS players on the server, with players now able to revive each other.

The game also expands by adding to the roster of supported languages. As of today, Flashing Lights is fully localised in Traditional Chinese, French, Dutch, Swedish, Danish, Brazilian Portuguese and Polish, adding to the already supported English, Japanese, Simplified Chinese, German, Russian, Spanish and Latvian.

Flashing Lights' Q3 2019 Early Access roadmap has also been announced today. The much requested police computer and database search will debut this month, allowing players to research NPCs to check for any criminal record. Controller support and new firefighting missions will launch in August and September respectively.

Flashing Lights launched in Early Access in June 2018, and is a one-man development.
