Program & Policy Guide



Overview

The RealWear Developer Program ("RDP") provides application developers the tools and support needed to deliver innovative solutions end users desire on RealWear's industry-leading, handsfree devices for the industrial worker.

The RealWear developer community is a diverse set of companies. Some developers design applications to meet a specific use case for exclusive deployment. Others deliver a suite of solutions across a wide array of devices, platforms, industries and customers. While others support the needs of an individual organization. Each developer is unique. The RDP offers the flexibility to match the best resources to meet the developer's needs and help fuel success.

RealWear Developer Program Requirements

Technical Capability

The RDP supports technically competent application development teams in pursuit of launching one or more applications on RealWear devices. RDP applicants should have a demonstrated ability to develop a working application on handsfree-dependent Android devices, preferably an application planned for deployment on RealWear devices.

Developer Agreement

RDP applicants must sign the RealWear Developer Agreement ("RDA"), which is acknowledged and accepted during the RDP subscription process.

Enrichment Investment

Subscription to the RDP is \$1,200 annually, paid in advance.

Upon subscription to the RDP, developers will be provided access to "Developer Mode" within RealWear Cloud Pro. . Developers must register a workspace ID within RealWear Cloud Pro which can be obtained at the following: https://www.realwear.com/cloud/.

Development Device Purchase

To aid developers in application development for RealWear devices, developers must purchase the specific RealWear device in which they are developing the application for. Devices may be purchased from any of RealWear's approved resellers. Each device must be registered to the developer's RealWear Cloud Pro workspace account.

Application Quality Standards

Developers must ensure their application(s) function properly with each firmware release. RealWear provides early firmware access and documentation to assist developers with application updates. Within four (4) weeks following each firmware release, all developers must certify that their application(s) are functioning properly. Failure to certify that an application is functioning properly and/or consistent quality complaints from customers, may result in application removal and/or termination from the RDP.



Developer Benefits

The RDP addresses developer needs across the application development cycle from assessment to training to validation to promotion and delivery. RDP membership benefits are described below:

Developer Knowledge Base. A bevy of self-service materials to address all aspects of developing for RealWear devices.	Access to RealWear's self-service materials to aid developers in developing applications for use on RealWear devices.
Technical Assistance Dedicated engineering team focused on developer success and provides tools and support.	 Device-specific Issue Resolution. Sometimes a little help is needed developing apps for RealWear devices. The RealWear team will assist the developer in overcoming bugs and hurdles in the app development process. Assessments & Validation. Prior to publication, the RealWear team reviews the app for readiness. User Experience Library and Github Access. Code shortcuts to streamline development and deliver the RealWear user experience customers expect. Early Firmware Access. To keep up with Android requirements, RealWear releases three to four updates per year. Developers receive early access to prepare their applications for limited customer impact. Community Chat. Access to RealWear developer discord community to ask questions when building or maintaining apps.
Marketing & Sales Tools and opportunities to promote and sell applications to RealWear customers.	 App Marketplace. RealWear customers have access to find solutions within our online app catalog and our partner directory. Only those developers subscribed to the RDP are able to upload apps into RealWear's online app catalog. RealWear Cloud. Access to RealWear's powerful mobile device control tool, to deploy and manage applications. Dedicated Point of Contact. Regular communication with RealWear's strategy team who will help review, advise and evangelize applications to the RealWear sales and marketing teams globally.

Maintaining RDP Status

Eligibility for membership in the RDP is dependent upon developers remaining in compliance with the Developer Requirements found in this Development Program and Policy Guide and the terms of the RDA. If the developer fails to meet any of the Developer Requirements or breaches any of the terms of the RDA, RealWear may reclassify a developer's application and/or terminate developer's membership in the RDP.
