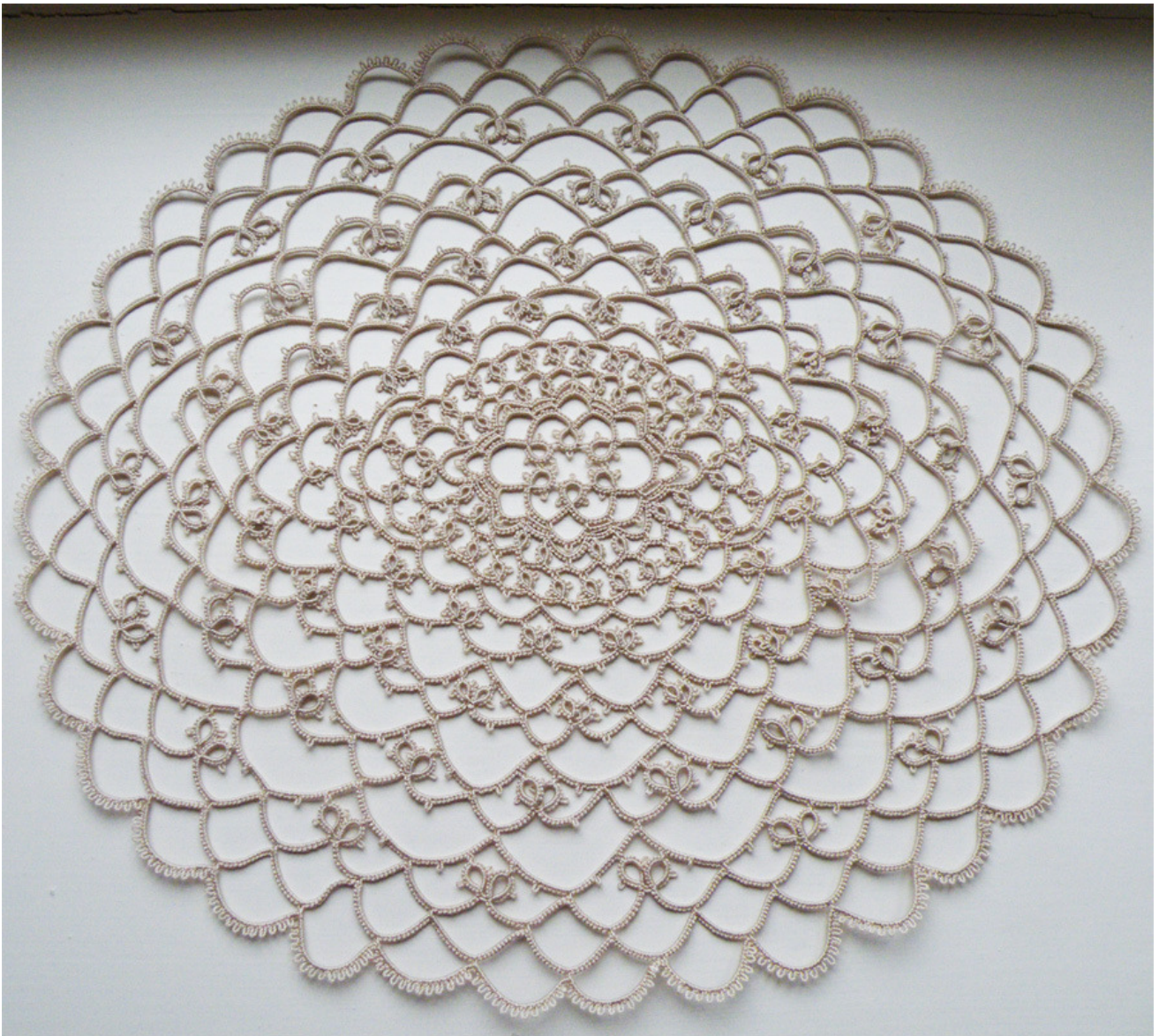


Oval Doily in ecru



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Materials:

Mergerised cotton size 40 (one ball), two shuttles

Special note: The split chains are worked from the chain/wrong side of the doily. If you work a split chain by turning your work round, then you will have to adjust the DNRW or RW that is written in the pattern to the opposite.

Wind shuttles with CTM

Round 1 Fig 1

- R1 3 - 3 - 3 - 3 - 3 - 3 cl, RW
Ch1 5 - 5 - 5, RW
R2 3 - 3 + (j to 4th p on R1) 3 - 3 - 3 - 3, cl RW
Ch2 5 - 5 - 5, RW
R3 3 - 3 + (j to 4th p on R2) 3 - 3 - 3 - 3, cl RW
Ch3 5 - 5 - 5 - 5 - 5, RW
R4 3 - 3 + (j to 4th p on R3) 3 - 3 - 3 - 3, cl RW
Ch4 5 - 5 - 5, RW
R5 3 - 3 + (j to 4th p on R4) 3 - 3 - 3 - 3, cl RW
Ch5 5 - 5 - 5, RW
R6 3 - 3 + (j to 4th p on R2) 3 - 3 + (j to 2nd p of R1) 3 - 3, cl RW
Ch6 Split chain 5 - 5 - 5 - 5 / 5, DNRW

Round 2 Fig 2

- Ch1 5 - 5, lj to next p of chain on Round 1
Ch2 5, lj to next p of same chain on Round 1
Ch3 5 - 5, lj to next p of next chain on Round 1
Ch4 5, lj to next p of same chain on Round 1
Ch5 5 - 5, lj to next p of chain on Round 1
Ch6 5, lj to next p of same chain on Round 1
Rep Chs 5 and 6 onto same chain on Round 1
Continue all around joining to starting point of Ch1, DNRW

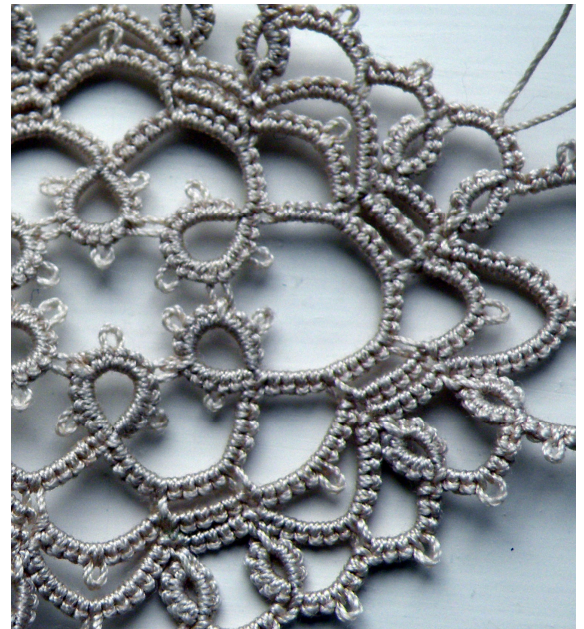

Round 3 Fig 2

- Ch1 7 - 7, lj to tiny sp bet Chs 1 & 2 on Round 2.
Ch2 5, lj to next tiny sp bet Chs 2 & 3
Rep Chs 1 & 2 twice more
Ch7 10 - 10 lj to next tiny sp
Ch8 5, lj to next tiny sp
Continue all around, making Chs 1 & 2 and then Ch7 again for Ch15
Lj to starting point of Ch1. RW

Round 4 Fig 3

R1 SR 5 / 5, cl, RW

Ch1 3 - 3, lj to next p of Ch1 on Round 3, 3 - 3, RW

R2 5 + (j to tiny sp bet Chs 1 & 2 on Round 3) 5, cl, RW

Ch2 3 - 3, RW

R3 5 + (j to tiny sp bet Chs 2 & 3 on Round 3) 5, cl, RW

Rep from Ch1 twice more.

Ch7 3 - 3 - 3 - 3, RW

R8 5 + (j to centre p of Ch7 on round 3) 5, cl, RW

Ch8 3 - 3 - 3 - 3, RW

R9 5 + (j to same place as R8) 5, cl, RW

Ch9 3 - 3 - 3 - 3, RW

R10 5 + (j to next tiny sp bet Chs 7 & 8 of Round 3) 5, cl, RW

Ch10 3 - 3, RW

R11 5 + (j to next tiny sp bet Chs 8 & 9 of Round 3) 5, cl, RW

Ch11 3 - 3 lj to p of next Ch on Round 3) 3 - 3, RW

R12 5 + (j to next tiny sp bet Chs 9 & 10 of Round 3) 5, cl, RW

Rep in this way as before until R17 has been made.

Ch17 3 - 3 - 3 - 3, RW

R18 5 + (j to centre p of Ch15 on round 3) 5, cl, RW

After 4th round completed, showing threads ready for round 5 following the last split chain.



Ch18 3 - 3 - 3 - 3, RW
 R19 5 + (j to same place as R18) 5, cl, RW
 Ch19 3 - 3 - 3 - 3, RW
 R20 5 + (j to next tiny sp bet Chs 15 & 16 of Round 3) 5, cl, RW
 Ch20 SC 3 / 3

Round 5 Fig 4

R1 SR 3 - 3 / 3 - 3, cl RW
 Ch1 3 - 3, RW
 R2 3 - 3 + (j to next free p on Round 4) 3 - 3, cl RW
 Ch2 3 - 3, RW
 Rep R2 and Ch2 8 times more
 R11 3 - 3 + (j to centre p of next Ch on Round 4) 3 - 3, cl RW
 Ch11 5 - 5, RW
 R12 3 - 3 + (j to first p of next Ch on Round 4) 3 - 3, cl RW
 Ch12 5 - 5 - 5 - 5, RW
 R13 3 - 3 + (miss next p of same Ch and j to next p) 3 - 3, cl RW
 Ch13 5 - 5, RW
 R14 3 - 3 + (j to centre p of next Ch on Round 4) 3 - 3, cl RW
 Ch14 3 - 3, RW

Complete the second side to match the first side making the last chain a split chain. DNRW

Round 6 Fig 4

Ch1 5 - 5 - 5 - 5, miss the next Ch of Round 5 and lj to p of next Ch of Round 5
 Rep Ch1, 4 times more
 Ch6 5 - 5 - 5 - 5, miss the p of the next Ch on Round 5 and lj to the first p of the next chain of Round 5.
 Ch7 5 - 5 - 5 - 5, miss the next p and then lj to the next p of the same Ch of Round 5
 Ch8 5 - 5 - 5 - 5, miss the next Ch of Round 5 and lj to p of next Ch of Round 5
 Rep Ch8, 5 times more
 Rep Chs 6 & 7 once

Ch16 SC 5 - 5 - 5 / 5, RW

Round 7 Fig 4

R1 SR 3 - 3 / 3 - 3, DNRW
 R2 3 - 3 + (j to first p of next Ch of Round 6) 3 - 3, cl, RW
 Ch1 5 - 5 - 5 - 5, RW
 R3 3 - 3 + (miss next p and then j to next p of same Ch of Round 6) 3 - 3, cl, DNRW
 R4 3 - 3 + (j to first p of next Ch of Round 6) 3 - 3, cl, RW
 Ch2 5 - 5 - 5 - 5,

Rep Rs 3 & 4 and Ch2 5 times

R15 3 - 3 + (j to centre p of same Ch of Round 6) 3 - 3, cl, RW

Ch8 5 - 5 - 5 - 5, RW

R16 3 - 3 + (j to next p of same Ch of Round 6) 3 - 3, cl, DNRW

R17 3 - 3 + (j to first p of next Ch of Round 6) 3 - 3, cl, RW

Ch9 5 - 5 - 5 - 5, RW

Rep Rs 3 & 4 and Ch2 7 times

R32 3 - 3 + (j to centre p of same Ch of Round 6) 3 - 3, cl, RW

Ch17 5 - 5 - 5 - 5, RW

R33 3 - 3 + (j to last p of same Ch of Round 6) 3 - 3, cl, DNRW

R34 3 - 3 + (j to first p of first Ch of Round 6) 3 - 3, cl, RW

Ch18 SC 5 - 5 / 5 - 5, DNRW

Round 8 Fig 5

Ch1 5 - 5 - 5 - 5 - 5 - 5, lj to centre p of next Ch of Round 7

Rep all round making the last Ch a split chain as follows:

Ch18 SC 5 - 5 - 5 - 5 - 5 / 5, RW

Round 9 Fig 5 & 6

R1 SR 3 - 3 / 3 - 3, cl, DNRW

R2 3 - 3 + (j to first p of next Ch of Round 8) 3 - 3, cl, RW

Ch1 7 - 7, lj to centre p of same Ch of Round 8,

Ch2 7 - 7, RW

R3 3 - 3 + (j to last p of same Ch of Round 8), 3 - 3, cl, DNRW

R4 As R2

Rep from Ch1 all round making the last chain as follows:

Ch36 SC 7 / 7, DNRW

Round 10 Fig 7

Ch1 6 - 6 - 6 - 6 - 6 - 6, miss p of next Ch of Round 9 and lj to p of next Ch.

Rep all round making last chain as follow:

Ch18 SC 6 - 6 - 6 - 6 - 6 / 6, RW

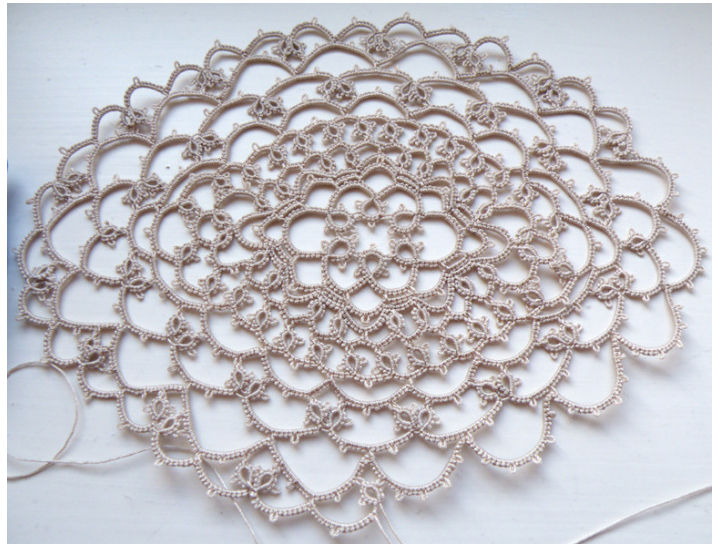

Round 11 Fig 7

- R1 SR 5 - 5 / 5 - 5, cl, DNRW
R2 5 - 5 + (j to first p of next Ch of Round 10) 5 - 5, cl, RW
Ch1 9 - 9, lj to centre p of same Ch of Round 10,
Ch2 9 - 9, RW
R3 5 - 5 + (j to last p of same Ch of Round 10), 5 - 5, cl, DNRW
R4 As R2

Rep from Ch1 all round making the last chain as follows:

- Ch36 SC 9 / 9, DNRW

Round 12 Fig 8

- Ch1 7 - 7 - 7 - 7 - 7 - 7, miss p of next Ch of Round 11 and lj to p of next Ch.

Rep all round making last chain as follow:

- Ch18 SC 7 - 7 - 7 - 7 - 7 / 7, RW

Round 13 Fig 8

- R1 SR 5 - 5 / 5 - 5, cl, DNRW
R2 5 - 5 + (j to first p of next Ch of Round 12) 5 - 5, cl, RW
Ch1 11 - 11, lj to centre p of same Ch of Round 12,
Ch2 11 - 11, RW
R3 5 - 5 + (j to last p of same Ch of Round 12), 5 - 5, cl, DNRW
R4 As R2

Rep from Ch1 all round making the last chain as follows:

- Ch36 SC 11 / 11, DNRW

Round 14 Fig 9

- Ch1 13 - 13, lj to p of next Ch on Round 13

Rep Ch1 all round making the last chain as follows:

- Ch36 SC 13 / 13, DNRW

Round 15 Fig 9

- Ch1 2 - 2 - 2 - 2 - 2 - 2 - 2 - 2 - 2 - 2 - 2 - 2 - 2 (13p's), lj to p of next Ch on Round 14

Rep Ch1 all round joining with a lj to the start of Ch1.

Tie knot, cut ends and sew ends into work neatly.
