ARMS: Left Arm: Attach B at left underarm marker on front. Pick up and k 9 sts between front marker and shoulder, then continuing down back, pick up and k 9 sts between shoulder and back marker. Starting with a p row, work in stockinette st on 18 sts for 6 rows more. Next row (wrong side): P across first 10 sts, then starting with a popcorn, work popcorn pattern as for first row of legs across last 8 sts (4 popcorns). Bind off. Right Arm: Work to correspond to left arm, starting with popcorns at beg of last row (instead of at end of row).

EARS (make 2): Starting at base of ear with B, cast on 6 sts. K 1 row. Working in garter st (k every row), inc 1 st at beg and end of next row. K even on 8 sts for 9 rows. Dec 1 st at beg and end of next 2 rows. Bind off remaining 4 sts. Sew ears in place. Thread yarn in tapestry needle and draw through sts around edge of ears; pull so that they cup slightly.

FINISHING: Sew rest of bear together, leaving opening for stuffing; stuff. Sew opening closed. Features: Nose: Starting at lower edge with black, cast on 9 sts. Work even in stockinette st for 2 rows, then dec 1 st at beg and end of every k row 3 times. P 1 row. K 3 tog. Break off. Sew nose to face. Follow photograph and stitch diagram. Embroider mouth and eyes in chain stitch with black yarn. Using blue yarn, work pupil in each eye with French knot. Make flower necklace (see General Directions).

Bangle-Bell Bossy




SIZE: 12" from nose to base of tail.

MATERIALS: Rug yarn, 2 ounces each natural (color A), dark brown (B) and olive (C); scraps of black knitting worsted for features; scraps of bright colored yarns in various weights for necklace; small bell.

BODY: Starting at lower edge with A, cast on 25 sts. P 1 row. 2nd row: K 5 A; attach B; k 10 B, k 5 A; attach C; k 5 C. 3rd row: P 5 C, p 5 A, p 9 B, p 6 A. Continuing in

stockinette st and starting with 4th row of chart, follow chart from right to left on k rows and from left to right on p rows. Place marker at beg of 8th row to indicate head. When chart has been completed, continue piece by working other side of Bossy as follows: Starting with 23rd row, read chart from top to bottom and place marker at end of 39th row to indicate head. When chart has been completed, bind off.

HEAD: 1st row: Attach A at first marker and pick up and k 21 sts between markers. 2nd row and all even numbered rows: P across. 3rd row: K 2 tog, k 6, k 2 tog, k 1, k 2 tog, k 6, k 2 tog, k 4, k 2 tog, k 1, k 2 tog, k 4, k 2 tog, k 1, k 2 tog, k 4, k 2 tog, k 1, k 2 tog, k 4. 9th row: K 3, k 2 tog, k 1, k 2 tog, k 4. 9th row: K 3, k 2 tog, k 1, k 2 tog, k 3. 11th row: K 2, k 2 tog, k 1, k 2 tog, k 2. Bind off remaining 7 sts.

LEGS (make 2 B and 2 C): Starting along side of leg, cast on 10 sts. Work in stockinette st for 4 rows. Bind off. Sew side edges together with p side out.

FINISHING: Fold body and head in half and sew together, leaving opening for stuffing; stuff. Sew opening closed. Placing legs so they curve as in photograph, sew C legs in front, B legs in back. Tail: With B, crochet a 4" chain. Break off. Sew to body. Cut 2 B and 1 C strands 5" long; draw half way through end of tail and tie. Using C double in a tapestry needle, starting at top of tail, make running stitches along top of Bossy to center of first row of head; pull up stitches drawing in Bossy's back about 1". Features: Follow photograph and stitch diagram. With black yarn embroider nose and eyes in chain stitch, eyelashes with straight stitches. Horns (make 2): With B and crochet hook, ch 8. 1st row: Sc in 2nd ch from hook and in next 6 ch. Break off. Sew in place. Make flower necklace (see General Directions). Tie bell to necklace.
