4. I (we) agree to be accountable for all aspects of the work in ensuring that questions related to the accuracy or integrity of any part of the work are appropriately investigated and resolved.		
<i>Additional criteria</i>		
5. I (we) am (are) able to identify, which co-authors are responsible for specific other parts of the work.		
6. I (we) am (are) confident in the integrity of the contributions of my co-authors.		

Explanations for fulfilling authorship requirements: For authorship of the manuscript, authors must meet all four mandatory criteria listed in the table (authors who fulfilled the criterion no 1 by substantial contribution should not be restricted in fulfilling criteria number 2 or 3).

Those who do not meet all required mandatory criteria for authorship (for example - manuscript writers, statistical advisors), should be acknowledged in the Acknowledgement section of the manuscript.
