

"BJP will cross 370 seats...": JP Nadda thanks Election Commission after voting concludes for last leg of LS polls

NEW DELHI [INDIA] : As the final phase of the Lok Sabha elections concluded today, marking the end of the world's largest polling exercise that began on April 19, Bharatiya Janata Party National President JP Nadda on Saturday thanked the Election Commission of India and claimed that BJP party will cross 370 seats.



The voting for the final phase of the Lok Sabha elections which began on April 19, came to an end on Saturday. "The final phase of the election has been completed. I would like to thank the ECI for successfully conducting the elections with proper arrangements. It is a matter to notice for the world how the ECI conducts elections in

under the vision of PM Modi. I want to thank PM Modi who worked so hard during the elections. PM Modi held over 206 election rallies, 23 roadshows, and almost 82 interviews he gave. He left no stones to reach the people of the country through these mediums. He raised the issues which people were not aware of. I want to again thank PM Modi," he added. BJP chief also thanked Union Home Minister Amit Shah who held more than 180 public meetings and roadshows. "I want to thank Rajnath Singh ji, and Nitin Gadkari ji who worked extensively during the elections. I thank PM Modi on behalf of all the party workers. I am thankful to all the leaders of NDA

allies who worked hard and tried to reach out to the people during the Lok Sabha elections. I believe that people have voted for 'Viksit Bharat', 'Saksham Bharat', 'Samarthavaan Bharat', and 'Aatmanirbhar Bharat.' The voters must have neglected the people who indulge in appeasement politics, dynastic politics, and corruption. I am confident that Bharatiya Janata Party will get more than 370 seats and NDA will cross 400 seats," he said. The voting for the marathon seven-phase polling process for the Lok Sabha elections, which began on April 19, came to an end Saturday. The seventh and the final phase of polling for Lok Sabha elections across seven

states and the Union territory of Chandigarh saw a voter turnout of 58.3 per cent till 5 pm, the Election Commission (EC) said. Earlier, as the 7th Phase of polling in General Elections 2024 wrapped up, the Election Commission of India thanked all stakeholders: voters, polling personnel, security forces, media, and political parties. Polling for the earlier six phases of Lok Sabha elections was held on April 19, April 26, May 7, May 13, May 20, and May 25. Assembly polls have also been held in Andhra Pradesh, Sikkim, and Arunachal Pradesh. Odisha is seeing simultaneous polls to Lok Sabha and assembly in the last four phases.

Karnataka SIT arrives at Bhavani Revanna's house for questioning in kidnapping case

BENGALURU (KARNATAKA) : A Karnataka Police Special Investigation Team (SIT) arrived on Saturday morning at the Holenarasipura residence of Bhavani Revanna, the mother of suspended JD(S) leader Prajwal Revanna, for questioning. Prajwal Revanna who is accused in the obscene video case was arrested from the Kemppegowda International Airport in Bengaluru on Friday after his return to the country. A court has sent him to police custody for six days. Bhavani is accused in the kidnapping case registered under IPC sections 64(A), 365, 109, 120(B).

had filed an anticipatory bail in the kidnapping case in which her husband HD Revanna was arrested. Bhavani had moved the Karnataka High Court seeking relief from arrest by the SIT. Her husband, HD Revanna was arrested earlier in connection with the kidnapping case on April 29 and granted conditional bail by a special court for people's representatives. The case, registered on April 28 at the Holenarasipura town police station, involves allegations of sexual assault by Revanna and his son, Hassan MP Prajwal Revanna, against their house help. The Special Court of People's Representatives in Bengaluru on Friday granted the SIT six-day custody of Prajwal Revanna in connection with the alleged obscene video case.

CLASH BREAKS OUT BETWEEN AAP AND CONGRESS WORKERS OVER OUTSIDERS ENTERING POLLING BOOTHS IN PUNJAB'S GURDASPUR

GURDASPUR (PUNJAB) [INDIA] : A clash broke out between Aam Aadmi Party and Congress workers as some outsiders allegedly entered polling booths numbered 105 and 106 of Tagore Memorial School in Punjab's Gurdaspur amid a seventh and final phase of Lok Sabha elections on Saturday.

AAP leaders Neeraj Salotra and Bikramjit Singh Sodhi were seen speaking against the police officials. Deputy Superintendent of Police (DSP) Sukhpal Singh brought the matter under control.

Speaking on the incident, DSP Sukhpal Singh said, "While the voting going on in Tagore Memorial School Gopal Nagar, Nakul Mahajan, son of a Congresswoman councillor, had alleged that outsiders had come to the booth and were casting fake votes, after which an argument broke out between Congress and Aam Aadmi Party workers."

Aam Aadmi Party workers accused Congress of casting fake votes. However, police officers present on the spot assured them that there was no case of fake voting and no outsider was present at the booth.

According to the Permanent Mission of India to the UN in New York, Ruchira Kamboj formally assumed the position of PR / Ambassador of India to New York, upon presentation of her credentials to Secretary-General Antonio Guterres on 2 August 2022, the first lady diplomat from India to assume this position. She began her diplomatic journey in Paris, France where she was posted as the Third Secretary in the Indian Embassy to France from 1989-1991. From Paris, she returned to Delhi where she worked as Under Secretary in the Europe West Division of India's Ministry of External Affairs from 1991-96, dealing with France, UK, the BENELUX countries, Italy, Spain and Portugal. In this

capacity, she also handled India's relationship with the Commonwealth of Nations, representing the country at the 14th Commonwealth Heads of Government Meeting in October 1995 in Auckland, New Zealand. She was posted as Counsellor at India's Permanent Mission to the United Nations in New York from 2002-2005, where she dealt with a wide range of political issues, including UN Peacekeeping, UN Security Council Reform, the Middle East crisis etc. From 2006-2009, she was India's Consul General in Cape Town, South Africa whose position involved close liaison with the Parliament of South Africa. She was picked to be the Deputy Head of the Office of the Secretary-General at the Commonwealth Secretariat London. From 2011-2014, she was India's Chief of Protocol, the first and only lady so far in Government to have held this position. In this capacity, she directed all outgoing visits of the President of India, the Vice President of India, and the Prime Minister of India and

the External Affairs Minister of India.

Exit polls predict clean sweep for NDA in PM Narendra Modi's home state Gujarat

GANDHINAGAR (GUJARAT) : As the Lok Sabha elections 2024, spread across seven phases, concluded on Saturday, exit polls indicate that Prime Minister Narendra Modi led-NDA is securing victory on all the 26 seats in PM Modi's home state Gujarat.

The Lok Sabha elections for 25 seats in the state of Gujarat concluded in a single phase, i.e., in Phase 3 on May 7. Notably, the BJP's candidate for the Surat Lok Sabha constituency in Gujarat was elected unopposed after the Congress candidate's nomination was rejected. BJP candidate Mukesh Dalal was declared elected unopposed after the nomination of Congress' Nilesh Kumbhani was rejected, and other candidates withdrew from the contest. According to exit poll figures by Times Now ETG, NDA is set to sweep all 26 seats while the Congress-led INDIA bloc is failing to open its account in the state.

According to exit poll data by INDIA TV also, NDA is securing victory on all the seats while the INDIA alliance is unable to secure even one seat. In the previous Lok Sabha elections also in 2019 and 2014, the BJP had won all the 26 seats. Under the seat-sharing arrangement, Congress is contesting in 24 seats while the Aam Aadmi Party fielded its candidates in Bhavnagar and Bharuch constituencies.

MP: Court sends 4 accused, including CBI Inspector Rahul Raj, to judicial custody in nursing college scam

BHOPAL (MADHYA PRADESH) : A special CBI court on Saturday sent four accused, including CBI Inspector Rahul Raj to judicial custody in the nursing college scam. On the completion of their custody till today, the accused CBI Inspector Rahul Raj and intermediaries Om Goswami, Ravi Bhadoria, and Jugal Kishore were produced before the court of Judge Arvind Kumar Sharma and the court sent them to judicial custody. Earlier on Tuesday, nine accused namely, Inspector Sushil Kumar Majoka from MP Police (on attachment with CBI), Anil Bhaskaran, Tanveer Khan, Radharaman

Sharma, Sachin Jain, Ved Sharma, Preeti Tilakwar, Suma Anil Bhaskaran, Jalpana Adhikari, were produced before the court. All were sent to judicial custody. Notably, in compliance with directions from the High Court, CBI's Anti-Corruption Branch (ACB) in Bhopal had formed seven core teams and several support teams. These teams, composed of CBI officials, representatives from nursing colleges, and Patwaris, were tasked with inspecting nursing colleges across the state to ensure they met the required infrastructural and faculty standards.

NCDC data confirms 56 heat-stroke deaths in India: Sources

NEW DELHI [INDIA] : With scorching heatwaves gripping several parts of the country, at least 56 deaths from heatstroke have been confirmed in multiple states by the National Centre for Disease Control (NCDC), sources said on Saturday. According to sources, many states are underreporting deaths due to heatstroke. The data is based on reports submitted by states to the NCDC. "Full reports on heatstroke deaths are awaited from states like UP and Bihar, where, according to state data, 166 deaths are reported in UP, while 22 people have died of heatstroke in a hospital in Bihar," sources said. In May alone, 46 people have died due to heatstroke. However, suspected heatstroke cases in May were 1,918. According to data shared by states, over 7 lakh people were admitted to emergency departments of primary care hospitals. Of these cumulative sus-



pected heatstroke cases, there have been 24,849 since March 1. According to data released by the Union Health Ministry, the maximum deaths have occurred in Madhya Pradesh (14), followed by 11 deaths in Maharashtra. Although the reported numbers are expected to be higher. Dr Neeraj Nischal, additional professor in the Department of Medicine at AIIMS New Delhi, said, "If we don't take care of heat-related illness, there is a spectrum of manifestations - sunburn, cramps, muscle

pain, dizziness, and tiredness. These are the early warning signs." "If you don't acknowledge these symptoms, the blood pressure will start falling, and when it becomes non-recordable, that is when we say that the patient has landed up in shock," he said. "It is very important to identify the early signs and symptoms of heat-related problems. The earliest signs will be increased sweating, tiredness, dizziness, the possibility of fainting because of this type of change in blood pressure, and other things. These are the warning signs. Those with co-morbidities are at risk and those who have outdoor activities are at risk. If they don't hydrate themselves properly, they may have all these problems," he explained. He also said that people should refrain from drinking cold drinks and other types of aerated beverages since they are unhealthy, especially during heatwaves. "Cold drinks are not healthy drinks, especially during heatwaves. When you take a cold drink, your thirst will go away for a moment, but it's such a sugary drink that it will further dehydrate your body. This is not a healthy drink, and one should avoid cold drinks as a source of hydration in this heatwave," he said. "The best type of drink is water. Apart from that, one can have shikanji, lassi, and buttermilk - any type of healthy drink that will hydrate you. If you are sweating too much, ORS and other such stuff can also help," he added.
