

Khambhaliya receives 32.5% of season's rainfall

Meghraj sweeps in Khambhaliya division in first rains, rains up to 10 inches Water everywhere



Dwarka Khambhaliya
In Khambhaliya and Bhanwad sub-divisions, Megh Meher rained at the beginning of monsoon and a total of 10 inches of rain fell in Khambhaliya by six o'clock this evening. Along with this, two and a half inches of rain has also been recorded in Bhanwad taluk.

As if Meghraj had settled in Khambhaliya taluka, the torrential rain that started from around one o'clock this afternoon continued till around five o'clock in the afternoon. In which a torrential 5 inches of rain fell simultaneously from 2 to 4 in the afternoon, and a water-bombing situation was seen in the low-lying areas. Another 2 inches of rain fell after this. Thus, Meghraj, which had been raging since last night, had dumped a total of 10 and a half inches (241 mm) of water by 5:00 p.m.

The forecast issued by the Meteorological Department yesterday did not predict heavy rain in Devbhoomi Dwarka district. Even so, last night Megha's Mandana was done. Last night at around three o'clock in the city, the roads were flooded due to heavy downpour. Last night rainfall was 8 mm in Khambhaliya taluka and 4 mm in early morning in Bhanwad taluka. After this, 59 mm (two and a half inches) of rain fell in Bhanwad taluk with 55 mm of rainfall in Bhanwad taluk from 6 am to 9 am.

Due to the torrential rain, the Nagar Gate, Salaya Gate, Govind Lake, etc., were flooded in the low-lying areas here. Due to the heavy rains, small water bodies were flooded.

Bara, Vadtra etc. villages on the Khambhaliya-Dwarka route witnessed overflowing of many rivers with up to four inches of rain. Apart from this, rivers

overflowed due to five to six inches of rain in villages including Viramdal, Zaksia, Samor. Along with this, the villages on the Khambhaliya-Bhanwad route are also experiencing torrential rains. However, in Dwarka and Kalyanpur sub-divisions of Devbhoomi Dwarka district, there have been scattered showers and no significant rainfall. Today's rainfall has recorded 32.5 percent of the season's total in Khambhaliya panthak and 11.5 percent in Bhanwad taluka. In Khambhaliya last night, due to the rain shower, the people were suffering in the scorching heat due to the power supply disruption for a long time. The same situation was seen in the city in the afternoon as well and people have raised questions about the pre-monsoon operation of the power system with continuous power interruption for half an hour.

Due to the rain, there was a chill in the atmosphere for some time. But then there was an increase in agitation and baffara. Suryanarayan was not seen all day today.

Sunday, a large number of elderly people were seen on the roads to enjoy the fun of bathing in the torrential rains and the first rains. Due to this rain which has rained considerably in Khambhaliya Panthak and also in Bhanwad taluka, there is a lot of happiness among the earthlings.

Garbage piles were piled up near the government hospital in Khambhaliya

Khambhaliya government hospital which is the biggest hospital in Devbhoomi Dwarka district which was a 70 bed hospital which has now been converted to 150 beds. However, still on paper there are still 70 beds and not enough staff even for 70 beds when 150 patients and 500 additional O's per day. P.D. Even if there are not enough cleaners, littering has become commonplace. Even the patient's relatives have spread the dirt due to the spitting of leaves and the washing of food dishes. If there are piles of medical waste and dirt outside the hospital

compound, the situation is very bad due to the dirt, representations have been made to increase the staff and dispose of the dirt. After setting up government hospitals at the cost of crores, the dire situation of not having enough staff to manage them has become highly criticized, then the poor behavior of the health department of Gujarat towards Dwarka district is revealed. Dwarka Government Hospital, the second number in Dwarka district, also has a serious problem of filth and cleanliness even where there is no class-IV staff. In this regard, complaints are often made.

Ahmedabad 9th 'paying' city in the country

Highest average salary of 8.09 lakhs, 98% less than Mumbai and 88% less than Bengaluru

Among the highest average paying cities in the country, Mumbai tops the list with an average annual salary of Rs. 15.98 lakhs. Ahmedabad, the economic capital of Gujarat, ranks ninth in the list with the highest average salary of Rs. 8.09 lakhs. According to Foundit Inside Tracker's May 2024 final report, Vadodara ranks thirteenth on the list with the highest average salary at Rs. 7.12 lakhs. The highest annual salary in Ahmedabad is 98 percent lower than Mumbai and 88 percent lower than Bangalore.

Highest Salary in Vadodara 7.12 Lakhs

The gap between Vadodara and Ahmedabad in highest salary is Rs 97 thousand per annum and minimum salary is Rs 70 thousand. The highest salary in Vadodara is Rs 7.12

lakh and the minimum salary is Rs 4.13 lakh. Bengaluru leads the lowest paying cities in the country where the annual salary is 6.63 lakhs while in Mumbai it is 6.22 lakhs. It is to be noted that the country has recorded an increase of 11 percent in the hiring index in one year. The index was 265 in May 2023 which has reached 295 in May 2024.

8 percent increase in hiring index in Vadodara city

Vadodara city has recorded an increase of 8 percent in the hiring index in the five months of the year 2024. The index was 207 in January which has increased to 223 in May. In Ahmedabad, a general increase of 3 percent has been recorded in the index during this period. In Ahmedabad, the index was 353 in January, which has increased to 364 in

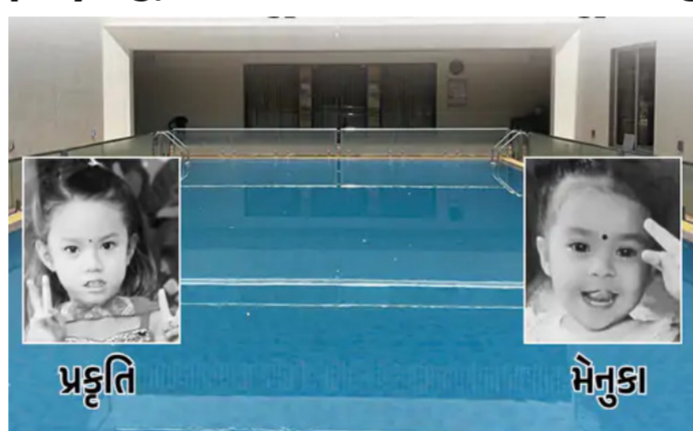
May. It is to be noted that the highest index has been recorded in the month of April in both the cities. In Ahmedabad it was 385 while in Vadodara it was 226.

5% increase in freshers hiring in the last 6 months in the country

The demand for freshers has increased by 5% in the last 6 months, mainly due to the gradual increase in job opportunities in the IT sector. The freshers have got the highest number of jobs at 32% in the IT sector and 12% in the staffing industry. According to a Foundit report, startups in the IT services and internet industries played an important role in hiring new graduates, where 23% and 22% of jobs were awarded to them, respectively. The national capital tops the list in employing freshers with 21%.

Don't leave children behind

Two 3-year-old girls in Rajkot fell into the swimming pool while playing, both died after drowning

Two 3-year-old girls of a Nepali family living in the Shilpan Onyx apartment on University Road in Rajkot city and guarding there fell into the swimming pool while playing. However, both of them drowned before anyone could save them. After 9.30 pm at the swimming pool of the society, both the girls died due to drowning in the water for about an hour. The locals called 108 and tried to save both the girls. But both the girls died on the spot.

The incident is that two girls died after drowning in the swimming pool last night at Shilpan Onyx Society on University Road. On learning about the incident, the people of the society got together and took both the girls out of the swimming pool and shifted them to the hospital through 108.

But after learning that both the girls have died, the family members are in mourning.

The family of both the girls are natives of Nepal and the staff of the civil post reported the incident to the university police and the police shifted the bodies to the civil hospital and took necessary action. In the police investigation, it was revealed that the age of both

the girls was 3 years. In which one's name is Prakriti Gokul Chand and the other girl's name is Menuka Prakash Singh. The families of both the girls are natives of Nepal and work as watchmen here in the Shilpan Onyx building. Harshal Sevak, a resident of the society, said, "I live in this society." Yesterday being Sunday, everyone went to see a picture in the theater at the society's club house at 9.30. An hour or so later a girl was seen in the water while passing by another swimming pool of the society and another girl was also seen in a few minutes. 108 was also informed immediately, but both the girls were found dead. The swimming pool is covered, however, both the girls reached inside and both slipped and fell in and are believed to have drowned.

This is not an incident that parents should learn from, but a similar tragedy took place in Rajkot last March. Today again in this accident in Rajkot, when two girls have died, parents should also take a lesson and it is necessary to make such arrangements that the children cannot go inside the swimming pool alone in the society.

Cheating in NEET; Police get evidence from NTA in case of theft at Jalaram School in Godhra

Panchmahal Police has succeeded in getting evidence from NTA on the issue of conspiracy to cheat in Godhra NEET exam.

In the case of conspiracy to steal selected students from the NEET examination center at Godhra, all the information of students from Gujarat and outside the state of Gujarat found in the police investigation and information including CCTV footage of the day of the examination and other documentary evidence by the Panchmahal Police and the investigating officer of this case to the National Testing Agency through email.

Even after two requests, the police reached the National



and spent two days to obtain all the necessary documentary evidence such as the names of the students, their addresses and other important information and also the CCTV footage of the examination day of the NEET examination center at Godhra.

The Panchmahal Police

team has returned to Godhra after collecting all the information. Now on the basis of the important documents received by the NTA and the CCTV footage, the investigation will be conducted further, in which many things will be clarified along with the shocking revelations.
