**Over 2.5m jobless youths come under job portal**

Minister for Skill Development Gautam Tetwal has said that 2.5 million jobless youths have been registered in the employment portal.

Tetwal gave the information in reply to a question raised by Congress legislator Bala Bachchan in the House on Monday. Bachchan wanted to know the number of unemployment youths up to May 31, 2024.

Tetwal said that Employment had been provided to 2.32 million youths in private sector in the past three years.

The information about government and semi-government organisations is not provided through the portal, Tetwal said.

**26K youths registered, 369 imparted training**

The government's Sikho Kmao Yojna (Learn and Earn Scheme) is gasping for breath. Minister Gautam Tetwal said 26,000 youths from Chhindwara were registered for training. Out of 26,000, 369 are being imparted training. Five of them have completed it.

**No change in train schedule**

**Indore:** There is no change in the time table of trains operating from the city railway stations.

The current time table will remain in force till December 31, 2024 and the new time table will be applicable from January 1, 2025. Along with this, the 'Train at a Glance' issued by the Indian Railways, has been extended till December 31, 2024 and a new 'At a Glance' will be issued on January 1, 2025.

It may be noted that over 45 trains are daily operated from the city railway stations, including main railway station, Mhow, Park Road and Laxmibai Nagar.

**Intermittent rains lash city, day temp drops to 30°C after four months**

Intermittent rain lashed the city consecutively for the fourth day on Monday, providing relief from the humid weather. The intensity of rainfall in the central and eastern parts of the city was high as compared to the western part, which witnessed light showers till evening.

According to the officials of the regional meteorological department, the city recorded 0.1 mm rainfall at the Airport throughout the day with which the total rainfall of the season has reached 100.6 mm (4 inches) so far.

The regional meteorological department said the conditions would remain the same for the next couple of days and the city would witness

light to moderate showers.

On Monday morning, the residents woke up to dark clouds and rain and could not see sunshine throughout the day. The rain, which started at noon, continued till late at night. "The monsoon is active across the state and the conditions will remain the same for the next couple of days," the Met officials said.

**No end to water-logging in basement of Government Cancer Hospital**

Renovation stalled despite six months of effort

More than six months have passed since the plan to renovate the basement of Government Cancer Hospital was initiated, yet the project remains incomplete.

Managed by Indore Development Authority (IDA), the renovation work has been halted for the last three months. The medical college management had allocated a tender worth ₹95 lakh to IDA for this project, which included sealing the basement's water sources and creating new facilities.

Despite approximately 80 per cent of the work being completed and a significant portion of the budget spent, waterlogging issues persist,

leading to a temporary suspension of the project. The basement, unused for the last 20 years due to water-

logging, was intended to house a new OPD for cancer patients, a waiting hall, consultant rooms and additional spaces for medical PG students and doctors. A year ago, budget for renovation was approved, with the project slated for completion by March 2024.

The medical college management, under the guidance of the then divisional commissioner Pawan Sharma, had formulated an action plan to address water issues. However, ongoing water leakage problems have put a pause on the much-needed renovations. Meanwhile, hospital authorities said that they are expecting that the work will be completed soon as they have planned to use the basement as the extended OPD of the hospital.
