

GMCH-32 has pending claims of ₹.42 cr under PMJAY: Report

THE AUDIT report of Government Medical College and Hospital, Sector 32 (GMCH-32) has revealed that the hospital has pending claims settlement under Ayushman Bharat Pradhan Mantri Jan Arogya Yojana (AB-PMJAY), amounting to Rs 1.42 crore in the period from 2019-2020 to 2022-2023.

According to the rules, the claim settlement/ payment is to be done within 15 to 30 days. A delay in submission of claims may result in rejection, which causes a loss of revenue to the hospital.

"Scrutiny of records revealed that the hospital (GMCH-32) has submitted total of 10,379 claims

amounting to Rs 29.25 crore... under PMJAY scheme from 2018-19 to 2022-23, out of which 385 claims amounting to Rs 1.42 crore pertaining to period 2019-20 to 2022-23 are still pending for settlement," the audit report claimed.

The report further found that as many as 92 claims till 2022-23 amounting to Rs 25,35,498 whose pre-authorisation was approved, were not submitted on the transaction management system (TMS).

"On being pointed out in audit, the department did not furnish any reply," the report added.

AB-PMJAY is a national public health insurance scheme that aims to provide free access to health insurance coverage for low-income earners in the coun-

try. The scheme provides a cover of up to Rs 5,00,000 to each eligible family per annum for secondary and tertiary care procedures covering surgery, medical and daycare treatments. The listed eligible beneficiaries are issued a card to avail of cashless and paperless services at empanelled hospitals, and healthcare providers across India, with GMCH-32 an Empanelled Health Care Provider (EHCP) under PMJAY.

After providing treatment, the EHCPs upload all the claim-related documents on the TMS and submit the claims to the State Health Authority/Insurance Company, which are then then scrutinised, following which payments are made to the empanelled hospitals. The timely system of settlement of claims is the backbone of the smooth functioning of the scheme.

During the audit of GMCH-32, the net position of claim settlements under the PMJAY scheme from 2018-19 to 2022-23 shows a detailed pendency from five regions, Chandigarh, Punjab, Himachal Pradesh, Jammu and Kashmir, Uttar Pradesh. The highest number of claims, 304, are from Punjab, with a pendency of Rs 10,25,039, followed by Chandigarh, with 59 claims and a pending amount of Rs 2,552,805.

Rs 12.25 cr revenue loss due to non-allotment of commercial space

As many as 11 establishments on the GMCH-32 campus, like a juice bar, Jan Aushadhi Drug Store,

barber and chemist shop, canteen and shops remained vacant for two to 17 months, resulting in a loss of rent, showed the report.

As the commercial establishment remained vacant, a loss of revenue of Rs 12.25 crore was incurred. Director-Principal of GMCH-32 rents out shops, canteens, parking lots, etc for one year by inviting e-tenders, which is extendable to another year. Not only did the establishments remain vacant, but the department could also not complete the re-tendering process after the completion of the previous contract. Not only a loss of revenue, with the shops lying vacant, patients could not use the facilities, causing inconvenience and hindrance to the patient care.

Shortfall in meetings on bio-medical waste management

Bio-medical waste management rules state that a system to review and monitor the activities related to bio-medical waste must be done through a committee that will meet once every six months and the record of the minutes of the meetings of this committee will be submitted along with the annual report. As per the audit, during the last check of the records GMCH-32, the bio-medical waste management committee meetings were not held in 2022-23. Non-holding of the meeting, observes the report, may adversely affect bio-medical waste management.
