

CM directs Revenue Dept to make Khatauni online by July 15

Chief minister Pushkar Singh Dhama has directed the officers of the Revenue department that the land records (Khatauni) of the people in the State should be made available online by July 15.

Dhama said that all the services being provided under the 'Apunni Sarkar Portal' should be provided to the people within the stipulated period of time. He added that the responsibility of the officers who are negligent in this regard should be fixed.

In the meeting, the CM directed the officers to expedite the process of Khatauni revision, updating records and preparation of a new database of the account and the co-account holders of the land.

The CM also directed the officers to conduct a survey of the entire land registered in the revenue records by using modern methods without delay.

The deputy chairperson of the State infrastructure monitoring council Vishwas Dabar, additional chief secretary Anand Bardhan, principal secretary RK Sudhanshu, secretaries Shailesh Bagoli, Chandresh Yadav, additional secretary Vijay Jogdande and others attended the meeting.

In the meeting the CM said that hearings should be made mandatory in the revenue courts two days in a week. He added that if a Magistrate is unable to sit in the revenue court on the date due to any reason, then it will be necessary for him to clearly mention it in the court diary. Anganwadi workers seek action from CM

The Anganwadi workers submitted a letter to chief minister Pushkar Singh Dhama on Monday to communicate their concerns regarding an increase in their monthly allowance and better retirement benefits. Stating this, the president of the Anganwadi Workers Association Rekha Negi informed that they have been consistently expressing the need for higher monthly wages and better retirement benefits to the State government for several years.

end of the MCC, they have now submitted the letter to the chief minister.

She informed that in the letter they emphasised that under the Mahila Kalyan Kosh Anganwadi workers have to deposit Rs 100 per month. Based on the total amount deposited in the Mahila Kalyan Kosh, a lump sum of Rs. 10 lakhs will be provided to retiring Anganwadi workers aged 60 or above, or in case of sudden death, to ensure their well-being, she said.

She further highlighted that this fund was contributed by the Anganwadi workers for a secure future post-retirement. Further, Negi added that the monthly salary of Anganwadi workers should be raised in addition to the enhanced retirement benefits. She further emphasised that if the government continues to ignore their demands, Anganwadi workers statewide will unite in protest until their grievances are addressed.

It will be recalled that prior to the implementation of the MCC, the Anganwadi workers had previously protested across the state for the fulfillment of their demands. Additionally during the protest, they also closed the Anganwadi centres across the state for an extended period of time.

Kandwal asks DPO to ensure proper treatment of minor giving birth

Taking serious cognisance of the case of a minor giving birth in Rishikesh, the chairperson of the Uttarakhand State Commission for Women (USCW) Kusum Kandwal instructed the Dehradun District Probation Officer (DPO) Meena Bisht to ensure proper care for the victim. Kandwal said that upon learning about the incident where a minor girl gave birth in Rishikesh, she visited the government hospital. She met the family members of the girl and obtained information about the health of the minor and the newborn from the hospital administration during her visit.

After questioning the minor girl and gathering necessary information, it was determined that the incident occurred within the Ranipokhari police station area, she said.

She further said that the police informed her that a case has been registered under the POCSO Act and rape charges, and the investigation has commenced. The accused boy, who is also a minor, is currently absconding, but efforts are underway to apprehend him and place him in Bal Sudhar Grah, she stated.

Kandwal further informed that she has also directed Bisht to dispatch a Child Welfare Committee (CWC) team to ensure the care and protection of the newborn. Following the directions, the CWC team arrived and proposed the option of placing the victim in the Government Shishu Sadan for treatment and care if she is unable to raise the child, Kandwal added.

To investigate the matter, a female sub-inspector was dispatched to the hospital.
