

Union Minister, Minister of State, Lt. Governor, Delhi and officers of Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change under the Campaign 'Ek Ped Maa Ke Naam' plant saplings at Asola-Bhati Wildlife Sanctuary

Taking forward the saplings plantation campaign by the Hon'ble Prime Minister on the occasion of World Environment Day on 5th June 2024, and to make the tree plantation campaign a mass movement, a tree plantation drive was organised today in Asola-Bhati Wildlife Sanctuary, New Delhi. The event was organised jointly by the Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change, Government of India and the Department of Forest and Wildlife, Government of NCT of Delhi. The event was graced by the Chief Guest, Union Minister for Environment, Forest and Climate Change, Shri Bhupender Yadav in the presence of Shri Kirtivardhan Singh, Minister of State for Environment, Forest and Climate Change, Shri Vinai Kumar Saxena, Lieutenant Governor, Delhi was also present during the event. Addressing the gathering, Shri Bhupender Yadav said that the initiative launched by Hon'ble Prime Minister in Buddha Garden, New Delhi on World Environment Day would help in achieving the green cover targets to achieve green economy and to adopt sustainable lifestyle for combating the challenges of climate change. He pointed out that there is a need to maintain a balance between scientific progress and nature. Shri Yadav highlighted the importance of deep ecological

sense which calls for deep organic relations between nature and its people. He also referred to the environment friendly lifestyle as mentioned by the Hon'ble Prime Minister in Glasgow Conference where he announced the need to adopt LIFE or Lifestyle for Environment as an important step towards combating climate change collectively. Shri Yadav elaborated that during the multilateral meetings with other countries, Hon'ble Prime Minister has provided leadership in adopting environment friendly lifestyle, reducing carbon emission and use of renewable energy through Mission Life, International Solar Alliance, Coalition for Disaster Resilient Infrastructure, International Big Cat Alliance and such other initiatives. India fulfilled its commitment to reduce intensity of carbon emissions ahead of 9 years of targeted timeline as per Paris Agreement. The Union Minister said that many important necessities like food, cooking oil, medicines, cosmetics, energy, etc. come from nature only and, therefore, it is our duty to protect nature and to achieve green targets and to increase biological diversity. Shri Yadav said that the Ministry is working on various schemes/programmes like Cheetah relocation, Project Tiger, Project Elephant, Project Lion, Big Cat Alliance and MISHTI, etc.

Major Reforms made in Draft Mining Plan Guidelines 2024 issued by Ministry of Coal

Guidelines aim to foster a more sustainable and ethical approach to coal mining

Coal mining in India has witnessed transformative changes in recent years, ushering in a new era marked by significant industry developments. The commencement of commercial coal mining has spurred unprecedented growth, with captive and commercial mines collectively surpassed 100 million tons in coal production during FY23 and likely to cross 200 million tonnes by FY26. The adoption of outsourcing models such as Mine Developer and Operators (MDOs) has emerged as a preferred business strategy, fostering extensive engagement from contractors and service providers. This trend also encompasses the auctioning of abandoned coal mines under a revenue-sharing framework.

The concept of a responsible mining, coal mine transformation strategies and "just transition" have gained prominence, emphasizing the imperative shift from coal-dependent economies to sustainable alternatives while ensuring the welfare of workers, communities, and the environment. This necessitates comprehensive measures encompassing support for affected workers, community development initiatives, environmental remediation, and policy reforms within existing guidelines.

In response to these developments, the Ministry of Coal (MoC) has revised the

framework of preparation of Mining Plan, a pivotal step to regulate and advance India's coal mining sector and issued draft guidelines on Mining Plan for consultation.

These guidelines serve as a strategic blueprint for coal mining companies, facilitating effective planning, execution, and monitoring of mining activities while upholding stringent environmental, social, and safety standards. The primary objective is to optimize coal resource extraction through sustainable practices that minimize waste and enhance operational efficiency. This strategic approach includes advanced technological integration to streamline operations, thereby achieving environmental and economic sustainability.

Safety and health measures constitute a cornerstone of the revised guidelines, ensuring the protection of mining personnel and local communities. Robust safety protocols and infrastructure are imperative to safeguard all stakeholders involved in coal mining operations.

The revised draft guidelines also focused on responsible mining practices that bolster the coal industry while prioritizing ecosystem preservation. This involves mandatory inclusion of restoration, remediation, and regeneration measures in mining plans to ensure sustainable natural resource

management. By minimizing environmental impacts, addressing community concerns, and promoting continuous improvement in water quality monitoring, the guidelines aim to foster a more sustainable and ethical approach to coal mining. Key reforms introduced in the revised draft Mining Plan & Mine Closure Guidelines include:

- Enhanced flexibility for minor modifications in Mining Plans, with major changes requiring approval from the Coal Controller Organization (CCO).
- Provision for calendar plan flexibility to accommodate increased annual coal production beyond scheduled targets.
- Mandatory reporting of other commercially valuable minerals found within leasehold areas to State Governments.
- Preference for blast-free and continuous coal-cutting technologies in mining methods.
- Implementation of comprehensive Safety Management Plans as per Coal Mines Regulations, 2017, including mandatory safety audits.
- Integration of fly ash filling protocols into mining plans to address related environmental concerns.
- Requirement for drone surveys and processed outputs for comprehensive five-year compliance reports of Mining Plans.
- Inclusion of sand for

stowing in mines within revised guidelines.

- Provision for extraction of barrier coal in adjacent mines to conserve coal reserves.
- Facilitation of mine amalgamation for safer and more efficient operations, including the use of deoiled voids for overburden dumping.
- Permission for project proponents to exclude non-viable areas within allocated blocks with detailed justifications.
- Guidelines for dumping overburden in areas outside coal blocks.
- Certification of project boundaries based on DGPS surveys for coal blocks allocated through auction or allotment.
- Standardization of Heavy Earth Moving Machinery (HEMM) specifications to ensure safety, efficiency, and interoperability in coal mining operations.
- Mandatory adoption of conveyor belts or railway transport for coal evacuation, promoting environmental sustainability.
- Requirement for mechanized loading to optimize coal movement from siding to end-users, enhancing operational efficiency and environmental protection.
- Mandatory preparation of Temporary and Final Mine Closure Plans for abandoned or discontinued mines post-2009.

These guidelines are now under stakeholder consultation to facilitate an

inclusive and comprehensive review process, ensuring that all relevant perspectives are considered. The stakeholders are requested to submit their comments by 1st July 2024.

The Ministry of Coal remains committed to fostering sustainable development and environmental stewardship in India's coal mining sector.

These comprehensive reforms underscore ministry's dedication to responsible resource management, community welfare, and environmental conservation.

"Medical Care Arrangements for Haj Pilgrimage" document unveiled by Union Health Ministry

Release of document institutionalizes comprehensive healthcare planning for Indian Haj pilgrims in Saudi Arabia involving multiple stakeholders



Union Health Secretary, Shri Apurva Chandra released a document titled, "Medical Care Arrangements for Haj Pilgrimage", here today, in collaboration with the Ministry of Minority Affairs. Shri. Mohammed Shahid Alam, Consul General of India in Jeddah (who joined virtually), and other stakeholders were also present. Haj represents the largest and most enduring annual mass gathering event globally. The responsibility for medical care arrangements lies with the Emergency Medical Relief Division and the International Health Division of the Directorate General of Health Services under Ministry of Health and Family Welfare. On the occasion, Shri Apurva Chandra stated that "this document lays the roadmap of the health services and how those services can be availed of by the pilgrims." Noting that this is only the second year since the healthcare responsibilities have been assigned to the Union Health

Ministry, he stated that "the experience has provided significant learnings for improving the healthcare services. Around 1,75,025 pilgrims undertook the Haj pilgrimage this year from India, of which approximately 40,000 are elderly people were above the age of 60. In view of the harsh weather conditions this year, the health challenges have necessitated round the clock services for the pilgrims. Last year, oral health and dental care services have been added learning from the past experience". The Union Health Secretary also added that nearly 2 lakh OPDs have been conducted this year, along with visits by the medical teams to the pilgrims. Shri Apurva Chandra stated that with the help of NIC a live portal has been developed that provides real time data and analysis on the pilgrims seeking medical care and the services being provided. "We are continuously monitoring and this will help us to improve our services significantly, such that we become the beacon of excellence to be emulated by other countries", he added.

The Union Health Secretary said that "it is a matter of pride to be of assistance to our citizens wherever they might be. Be it for evacuating our students from Ukraine or assisting our people who got stuck in the fire incident in Kuwait, India has always been at the forefront in helping its citizens."
