

Modi completes his 45-hr long meditation at Kanyakumari



MI News Service, Chennai: Prime Minister Narendra Modi on Saturday concluded his 45-hour long meditation at the Vivekananda Rock Memorial here and paid floral tributes to Tamil saint poet Thiruvalluvar. On conclusion of his dhyana session, Modi, clad in white, visited the 133-ft statue of Thiruvalluvar, located next to the rock memorial and placed a huge garland there marking his tribute. He arrived at the statue complex by a ferry service and later reached the shore using the service. During his stay

at the memorial, the PM did meditation and also performed 'Surya Arghya' at the time of sunrise, a ritual associated with spiritual practice. Modi was clad in saffron while he was engaged in meditation at the Vivekananda Rock Memorial. Kanyakumari is famous for its sunrise and sunset and the memorial is located on a tiny islet near the shoreline. At the Vivekananda Rock Memorial, the PM embarked on his 45-hour long meditation on the evening of May 30 and completed it on Saturday.

Pune Porsche crash: Police arrests Minor's mother

MI News Service, Pune: Pune police have arrested the mother of the minor in the Porsche car accident case after confirmation that his blood samples were replaced with hers, the city police chief said on Saturday. She is likely to be produced in a court during the day.

As part of their probe, the police also spoke to the minor for about an hour at the observation home, where he has been sent till June 5, in his mother's presence.

Citing their investigation into the accident, Commissioner of Police Amitesh Kumar said the juvenile's blood samples were swapped with those of his mother.

Police had told a local court two days ago that the blood samples of the 17-year-old juvenile were exchanged with those of a woman.

"We will conduct the minor's inquiry inside the home in the presence of his mother," Additional Commissioner of Police (Crime) Shailesh Balkawade had said before police spoke to the minor.

The Juvenile Justice Board (JJB) on Friday permitted the police to probe the teenager. Under the

Juvenile Justice Act, the inquiry of a minor has to be conducted in the parents' presence.

Two IT professionals were killed in the early hours of May 19 in Kalyani Nagar in Pune after a Porsche allegedly being driven by the minor, who the police claim was drunk, rammed into their two-wheeler.

The minor's father, realtor Vishal Agarwal, and grandfather Surendra Agarwal have been arrested for allegedly kidnapping the family's driver and putting pressure on him to take the blame.

A court on Friday remanded the teenager's father and grandfather in judicial custody for 14 days after their police custody ended.

Police have also arrested Dr Ajay Taware, then head of the department of forensic medicine at Sassoon General Hospital, medical officer Dr Shrihari Halnor and employee Atul Ghatkamble for allegedly manipulating the minor's blood samples to show that he was not drunk at the time of the accident.

As per the police, about a dozen calls were exchanged between Vishal Agarwal and Dr Ajay Taware, one of the arrested doctors, while sam-

ples were being collected for testing for alcohol consumption.

Dr Halnor and Ghatkamble received a total of Rs 3 lakh from Dr Taware to change the blood samples, a senior police officer had said earlier.

Police on Friday moved an application for Vishal Agarwal's custody in connection with the alleged switching of the blood samples.

The JJB granted bail to the teenager a few hours after the May 19 crash and asked him to write a 300-word essay on road safety. Amid a nationwide outcry, police again approached the JJB, which modified the order and sent him to the observation home till June 5.

After the bail was given to the juvenile by a single member of the JJ Board, the Maharashtra government set up a committee to probe the conduct of the state-appointed members of JJB and check if norms were followed while issuing orders in the Pune car crash case.

The committee, headed by a deputy commissioner, will submit its report by next week, Prashant Naravare, commissioner of the Women and Child Department, had said earlier.

Govt won't protect anyone in illegal money transfer case: Siddaramaiah

MI News Service, Bengaluru: Karnataka Chief Minister Siddaramaiah and his deputy DK Shivakumar on Saturday asserted that the state government will not protect anyone in the illegal money transfer case involving the Karnataka Maharashtra Valmiki Scheduled Tribes Development Corporation Ltd and would take action in accordance with law.

The assertion comes hours after Opposition BJP sought a CBI probe into the illegal money transfer case and demanded that Minister of Scheduled Tribes Welfare, B Nagendra be dismissed.

"We will not protect anyone whoever it may be (involved in the case), we will take action in accordance with law," Siddaramaiah told reporters in response to a question on a case involving Minister Nagendra and BJP seeking his removal.

The illegal transfer of money came to light after the Accounts Superintendent at the Corporation, Chandrashekhar P, died by suicide on May 26, leaving behind a death note.

It revealed the unauthorised transfer of Rs 187 crore belonging to the corporation from its bank account, and from that, Rs 88.62

crore was illegally moved to various accounts allegedly belonging to "well-known" IT companies and a Hyderabad-based cooperative bank.

Chandrashekhar has named the Corporation's now suspended Managing Director J G Padmanabh, accounts officer Parashuram G Durugannavar, and Union Bank of India Chief Manager Suchismita Rawal in the note, while also stating that the "Minister" had issued oral orders for transferring the funds.

The state government has constituted a four-member SIT team headed by Manish Kharbikar, Additional Director General of Police, Economic Offences, at the Criminal Investigation Department (CID) in Bengaluru, to conduct the probe.

Deputy CM D K Shivakumar maintained that the government will not protect anyone and no one will be spared.

Addressing reporters here, he said, "The BJP is doing politics, I won't question them. During the BJP regime too such things have happened. Basavaraj Bommai (former CM) is aware of it, everyone else also knows it. We are investigating the case, we will not

spare anyone." When pointed out that while in opposition the Congress had sought the then Minister K S Eshwarappa's resignation following the suicide of a contractor naming him, but is not acting against its own Minister now, Shivakumar said there is no direct reference to Minister Nagendra in this case.

"If any documents or proof or any involvement is found, whatever needs to be done, the government will surely do it. The government is transparent, there is no question of sparing anyone. We will take action. We will protect the interest and safeguard the government. The money is important, our officials are trying to trace it," he said.

The Deputy CM further said that a couple of days is required. "After that the government will definitely take action. Some arrests have been made, actions have already been taken. The Minister has spoken to me and the CM, we are inquiring into it," he added.

On the demand for a CBI investigation, he said there is a procedure that if more than certain crores of money is involved in a bank fraud case (Rs 3 crore in

public sector banks), the case will naturally go to CBI.

"Whether we give it or not, there is a procedure, we also know that, we are ready to cooperate. They (CBI) should also probe without politics. As of now the case is not with the CBI, we are investigating," he added.

Meanwhile, amid media reports that a bank account named after IT firm Happiest Minds Technologies Ltd, is among the "beneficiaries" of the money embezzled at the Corporation, the company in a statement clarified that the bank account does not belong to it. "We have absolutely no connection to the bank account or the branch mentioned (RBL Bank, Banjara Hills, Hyderabad, IFSC Code RATN0000341) and this has been confirmed by RBL Bank authorities as well. We vehemently deny these malicious efforts to malign our Company's reputation," it said in a statement.

"We are confident that a thorough investigation will reveal the truth and expose those responsible for these false and baseless accusations. We are also pursuing all legal avenues available to us to protect our Company's reputation," it added.

be examined why Shivakumar made such an allegation.

Radhakrishnan also said that the government was investigating whether anything as alleged by the Karnataka Deputy CM happened anywhere else in Kerala, even though according to initial reports such an incident has not occurred in the state.

He also said that animal sacrifices were prohibited by law since 1968 and therefore, it was unlikely that it took place in Kerala.

The managing committee of the temple in question had on Friday refuted Shivakumar's allegations and termed his claims as 100 per cent false.

The Special Branch has also given a report to the State Police Chief stating there is no evidence of any animal sacrifice taking place near a temple in Kerala as claimed by the Deputy CM of Karnataka.

Shivakumar on Thursday had claimed that a ritual named "Shatru Bhairavi Yaga", which involves the sacrifice of animals, was performed at a temple in Kerala, targeting him, Siddaramaiah and the Congress government in Karnataka.

"We investigated the claim and also contacted the Malabar Devaswom Board. The preliminary report we got states that nothing like that has happened in or near the temple. The Devaswom Board also confirmed it," the minister said.

Jalpaiguri cocoa saplings to seed Assam chocolate

MI News Service, Jalpaiguri: Cocoa saplings from a research institute in Jalpaiguri will be sent to Assam for cultivation and the plant's seeds will be used for making chocolates and other items.

According to sources, Mondelez India Foods Private Limited, a subsidiary of Mondelez International which owns the globally famous Cadbury brand, will set up a plant in Assam to produce chocolates, beverages and other products.

"Along with the plant, the company has also decided to set up a cocoa plantation to use the tree's seeds, a primary ingredient of chocolates and similar products, at the site in Assam. For

the plantation, they have placed an order for 5,000 cocoa saplings with us," said Arun Kumar Sit, the scientist in charge of the CPCRI (Central Plantation Crops Research Institute) Research Centre located at Mohitnagar, on the outskirts of Jalpaiguri.

Headquartered in Kasaragod in Kerala, the CPCRI conducts research on coconut, areca nut, coco cashew and some other crops. It has several research centres in the country, including the one in Mohitnagar.

"They could have got the saplings from south India but the transport cost would have been much higher. That is why they

approached us. In the coming days, we hope we will get similar orders from the company and other firms," Sit said.

He said the saplings of the areca nut and the coconut were being sent to different northeastern states for cultivation. "But this is the first time that we will send cocoa saplings. Our research has worked and we could successfully come up with saplings which can produce rich quality cocoa pods," the scientist said.

Sit said a cocoa sapling grows within three years and starts producing pods which contain seeds. "A kilo of dry cocoa seeds costs around ₹250 in the market."
