

# Damacharla questions police on opening rowdy sheets on TDP workers

- Says the YSR Congress Party MLA candidate Balineni Srinivasa Reddy fears defeat in the election
- Alleges Balineni and his son Praneeth brought two thousand people into the GGH Ongole and tried to attack him
- Informs that he will file private complaints against police officers who worked for the YSRCP and harassed TDP workers

THE Telugu Desam Party Andhra Pradesh vice-president and Ongole MLA candidate Damacharla Janardhana Rao demanded the SP Garud Sumit Sunil to explain the reasons behind opening rowdy sheets on his supporters and party workers.

gole on Saturday, Janardhana Rao said that the YSR Congress Party MLA candidate Balineni Srinivasa Reddy fears defeat in the election, and is using the police officers to open rowdy sheets on

the TDP workers to prevent them from attending the counting as agents on behalf of their party. He said that the police quoted the incident at GGH Ongole as the base for the rowdy sheet.

He said that it is Balineni Srinivasa Reddy and his son Praneeth Reddy brought two thousand people into the GGH Ongole and tried to attack him, and the TDP leader Mohan Rao, who was

injured in the earlier attack by YSRCP people. He said that the police should have opened the rowdy sheets on Srinivasa Reddy and his son instead, they opened on the 62 TDP workers, including those who were not present at the incident.

Janardhana Rao announced that they would file private complaints against the police officers who worked for the YSRCP and harassed the TDP workers. He demanded the police to explain why they didn't open a rowdy sheet on Srikavya Reddy, daughter-in-law of Balineni, who is the reason for the disturbance on the day, and also the person who attacked voters inside a booth on the day of polling.

He said that the YSRCP is frustrated as it is going to lose in the election, and is trying to dominate in the counting by filing cases on the counting agents for the TDP. He assured the TDP workers that he would take responsibility for the cases, and fight in the court for them.

DISTRICT collector and district election officer M Venugopal Reddy said the district administration has made all the arrangements for counting of votes for Guntur Lok Sabha constituency and seven Assembly constituencies come under Guntur Lok Sabha constituency. He said fourteen tables were set up for Lok Sabha constituency and another 14 tables set up for each Assembly constituency for counting of votes. He said another 14 tables were set up for counting of postal ballot votes for Guntur Lok Sabha constituency and added that second randomisation will be

held for counting staff on June 3 and on the same day second time training classes will be conducted for the staff.

Speaking on the occasion, he said the counting of vote process will start at 8 am on June 4. As many as thirty candidates contested for Guntur Lok Sabha constituency and 132 candidates contested in the seven Assembly constituencies come under Guntur Lok Sabha constituency.

He said third time randomisation will be held on June 4 and employees will be allotted for the counting of votes in various Assembly constituencies coming under Guntur Lok Sabha constituency. Guntur district SP Tushar Dudi said that as many as 2,500 police personnel has been deployed for security and police pickets were set up at problematic villages in the district. He said section -30 of the Police Act was in force in the district and warned that if anybody violates the orders, the police will take stern action against them.

TIGHT security is being maintained at the strong rooms where the EVMs are kept under the supervision of the election officials of East Godavari, Kakinada, and Ambedkar Konaseema districts of the joint district.

There are three Lok Sabha constituencies and 21 Assembly constituencies in the joint East Godavari. The counting of service votes will begin at 8 am on June 4, followed by the counting of postal ballots.

Counting of votes will start at 8.30 am while postal ballot counting continues. Officials estimate that it will take half an hour to declare the first round result and twenty minutes for each subsequent round.

Officials said that the first result will come from Kovvur in the East Godavari district, Jaggampeta in the Kakinada district, and Razole constituency in the Konaseema district.

District Election Officer K Madhavi Latha and SP P Jagadeesh spoke about the counting process of East Godavari district at AKNU in Rajahmundry on Saturday.

According to EVM, postal ballot and ETPBS vote counting, 98 tables (116 rounds) have been set up for EVM votes in the parliament constituency, 98 tables (116 rounds) in Assembly constituencies, and 18 tables (one round) for ETPBS and postal ballot. A total of 17 counting centers have been set up. In this, 7 Assembly, 7 Parliament, and 3 are related to the postal ballot. He said that the ac-

tivity has been prepared so that the result of the Kovvur constituency (13 rounds) will be announced by 12 noon, and finally the result of Rajahmundry Rural (19 rounds) at 3 pm.

Bindover cases will be registered against those who commit and incite violent incidents, SP warned.

So far 130 cases have been registered and over 1,500 security personnel are participating in the counting duties. 162 problematic villages have been identified and surveillance will be increased in those areas along with continuous surveillance through drone cameras.

East Godavari SP Jagadeesh clarified that counting agents attending on behalf of political parties will be tested with a breath analyser and allowed to enter.

# 'Killing spree going on in Chhattisgarh'

THE Adivasi Hakkula Porata Sanghivhava Vedita (Adivasi Rights Struggle Solidarity Forum) has alleged that the killing spree has been going on for the past five months in Chhattisgarh and 120 adivasis have been killed by police forces on the stamp of Maoists.

They said a 60-member fact-finding committee headed by the Adivasi Rights Struggle Solidarity Forum reached Chhattisgarh via Telangana on Thursday and tried to meet the affected families there.

Andhra Pradesh Civil Rights Association Secretary Chiluka Chandrasekar Narayana Rao, Madana Kumaraswamy, and Jabli (Telangana) led the group that left and the police forces stopped them at Terlaguda.

It is alleged that they were warned to go back on the pretext of security reasons. They alleged that they were tired from the journey and requested that they will reach Bijapur and rest there, but the forces ignored their words and threatened them.

Finally, the committee was sent back to Bhadrachalam. As a result, their attempt to reach Dantewada via Chin-tour on Friday was blocked by forces at the Kunta border and they were surrounded by paramilitary forces.
