



Sambeladhar 5 inches of rain in Surat water

Varachha, Athwa, Vesu, VIP road inundated with twenty feet of water in the whole city; Vehicles stopped, houses flooded

While the Meteorological Department has predicted heavy to very heavy rains in the entire South Gujarat including Surat, on July 21 after 5 pm, about four and a half inches of rain fell in two hours. As a result, the city was flooded. All areas of the city including Varachha, Athwagate, Katargam, Punagam, Udhana were flooded. Due to which people had to face difficulties while returning from work. Two to two and a half feet of water filled the road and vehicles were stuck on the road. So the basement of the society was filled with water and water entered the house. Then Divya Bhaskar's team went to different areas of Surat City and made a ground report of the situation after the rain. Bhaskar reporters Deven Chitte, Sunil Paldia and Shweta Singh gave a picture of the situation.

In Varachha area Gothanasama Pani Surat received heavy rain in four hours with strong winds. Due to which there were incidents of falling trees. More than five inches of rain in three hours has flooded the city. At that time, Varachha area of the city was also flooded. The tank at Ashwinkumar has been closed due to flooding. It was raining for more than three hours.

The highest rainfall has fallen in the Varacha zone area. Five inches of rain has fallen in Varachha area in the last

three hours. In front of the Varachha police station, the water was filled up to Gothan. Shops on Varachha Main Road were also flooded. Along with this, the restaurants located at Mini Bazaar also had to face a lot of trouble due to the ingress of water. Sarthana area also received about five rains. From Varachha to Sarthana, everywhere was flooded due to it. Along with this, Sarthana Police Station and Utran Police Station were also flooded.

The posh area VIP Road was flooded in Surat after three hours of rain. VIP Road, a posh area of the city, was flooded. Due to which the people who came out with two-wheeler-four wheeler had to face a crisis. Vehicles were stuck in the middle of the road. People were troubled by waterlogging in the posh area. People were seen trying to reach home in rainy weather. Areas where pre-monsoon operations were carried out by the Municipal Corporation through advance planning were inundated. At that time, the car was parked on the side of the road waiting for the water to recede, and Pushparaj Duggal, who was stuck in the middle, said that there is water ahead. Can't go further. Was stuck for 20 minutes. He himself stayed there to receive his wife and family. Many people were trapped but the planning was good. According to the law of nature, this had to happen, but he hoped that everything would be fine in a

few minutes.

Sanyamnagari has been built for Jain Samaj's Chaturmas, there was water inundation on VIP road. In which vehicles including BMW cars were half submerged and there was water all around. Passing a vehicle on the road was like chewing iron. Some two wheelers had fallen. As many as 6 luxurious cars parked in front of Sanyamnagari were submerged in water.

Water entered people's houses in Palanpur Jakatnaka area. Houses in Vivekananda township were also inundated. The furniture of the house began to sink as the rainwater seeped in. Due to which the household had to be shifted to a safe place. More than 50 houses were inundated so that people sat on cots, couches or sofas. So the people in the house were also worried. They appeared to be waiting for the water to recede.

Bhatar Road area was filled with knee-deep water as the rainwater returned. So people had to face great hardship. The entire area was waterlogged due to heavy rain. Due to which vehicles including autorickshaws were stuck in the middle of the road. The rickshaw puller said that the water is flooded due to heavy rain. So his rickshaw was stopped four or five times. The rickshaw kept stopping despite starting it repeatedly. When a person passing by on the road got poisoned on the water-filled SMC. He said that if Surat was given the first number, such taps of this municipality would be filled. The work of the municipality is useless in our Surat. All these faucets are full. Do you know that when monsoon comes, everything should be cleaned or not? Such is the man with the municipality. Water has flooded everywhere. Want a sitting salary.

Before Floods

Do not spread rumours. Stay calm. Do not panic

Stay in touch with local administration and follow their guidelines

Mark and Memorize the route to the nearest safety location

Listen to Radio/Watch T.V for latest news & updates on weather and floods

Keep your mobile phones charged

Keep a first-aid kit with medicines for snake bite, dysentery and other common ailments

Keep an umbrella with you. Keep a stick handy to deal with poisonous snakes and other animals

Keep handy necessary items such as dry snacks, candles, matchsticks, kerosene, spare batteries, ropes, torch, clean drinking water etc

Untie your cattle for their safety

During Evacuation

Move to a higher place

Lock the house and reach the designated safe locations through the assigned routes

Keep sewage lines shut by putting sand bags to prevent flooding of the gutter

Pack a few pairs of clothes, essential medicines, valuable items, important documents etc. in a waterproof bag and keep the bag in your vicinity

Keep furniture, household items etc. on a higher level i.e., on a bed or a table

Shut down all power supplies and gas switches before leaving the house

Avoid venturing into unknown areas inundated by rainwater

During Floods

Stay away from water and waste disposal lines

Stay away from electric poles and live wires to prevent electrocution

Drink boiled water and ensure it is drinkable and germ-free

Spray bleaching powder to keep the surroundings free from germs and insects

Do not keep children hungry

Prefer eating freshly cooked meals and dry snacks

Keep the food covered at all times

After Floods

Listen to the instructions issued by regional officers and emergency services. Follow the issued instructions sincerely

Use a mosquito net to protect against malaria

Do not let children go near floodwater

Stay away from broken electric poles, damaged bridges and canals, broken glass, sharp objects etc.

Avoid using damaged electrical appliances. Use only if they are thoroughly checked by the electrician

Do not consume food that gets mixed with floodwater
