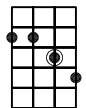


PLECTRUM BANJO MOVEABLE CHORDS

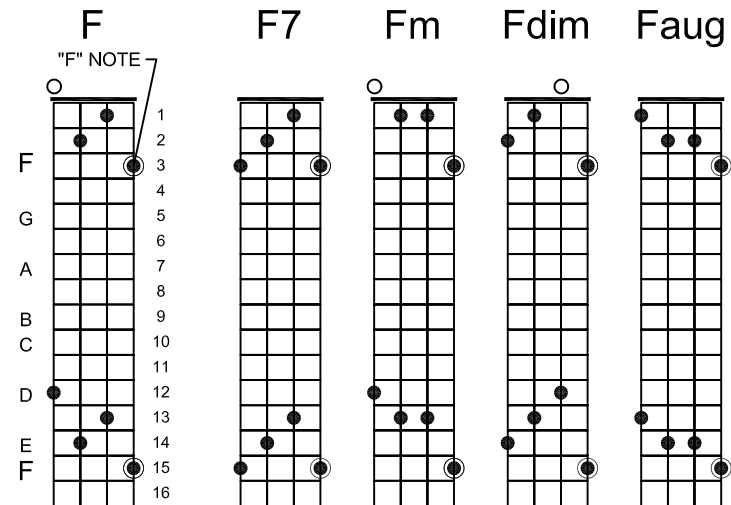


There are three moveable chord finger positions on the plectrum banjo as shown on the left. The chord name and note name are the same at the circled dot locations. The finger positions can be changed to make seventh, minor, augmented, and diminished chords as indicated in the following diagrams.

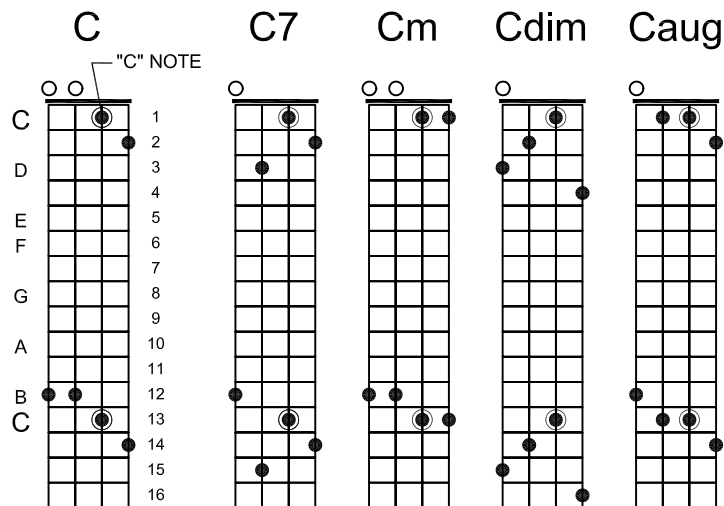


The chord/note names change as the finger position is moved on the fret board. Notice how the finger forms repeat every 12 frets.

MOVEABLE CHORDS - FIRST POSITION Name of the chord and note are the same on the FIRST string



MOVEABLE CHORDS - SECOND POSITION Name of the chord and note are the same on the SECOND string



MOVEABLE CHORDS - THIRD POSITION Name of the chord and note are the same on the THIRD string
