

## Petal Cone Takeout Box

## Supplies:

2 Petal Cone Die Cuts in Crumb Cake Cardstock Large Flower Fun Die Cut in Baja Breeze Cardstock Small Flower Fun Die Cut in Baja Breeze Cardstock Medium Flower Fun Die Cut in Springtime Vintage Fabric

10" Very Vanilla Satin Ribbon Large Rosette



## Directions:

- 1. Fold the Petal Cone Die Cut on the center score line. Line up the score line under the half circle with the 2" mark on the Paper Cutter and score. Flip it over and score the same on the other side.
- 2. Slide the die cut down so that the score line now lines up with the 3" line. Cut off the end (the point) of the die cut. Use scissors to cut on the middle and side lines from the bottom edge to the 2" score line.

Step 2 - Cut at 3"


- the bottom edge to the 2" score line. Completely cut off the small tab created from the side flap. (See first photo below.)
- 3. Fold on all score lines. Apply Sticky Strip at shown in the photos below.








4. Adhere the sides of the box together. Fold the round flaps down and turn the box upside on the flat table. Situate the box so the bottom flap without adhesive is on the bottom, closest to you. Fold the flap without adhesive down first and then follow counterclockwise (with the left, top, and right flap to follow). Make sure to steady the box and keep it square as you adhere the bottom flaps. Wrap the piece of Satin Ribbon around the box and adhere the ribbon to itself using Sticky Strip.







- 5. For the flower embellishment, sponge the edges of the Large Flower Fun Die Cut with Basic Gray ink. Use Tombow Multi Adhesive to adhere the layers of cardstock and fabric together. Bend and curl the edges of the flower to give it more dimension. Adhere the Large Rosette in the center using Mini Glue Dots.
- 6. Cut the banner tag in half. Ink only the "for you" portion of the "just for you" stamp in Basic Gray marker and stamp on the tag. Adhere the tag with a Mini Glue Dot under the second layer of the flower.
- 7. Attach the flower to the box using Stampin' Dimensionals on the ribbon.
