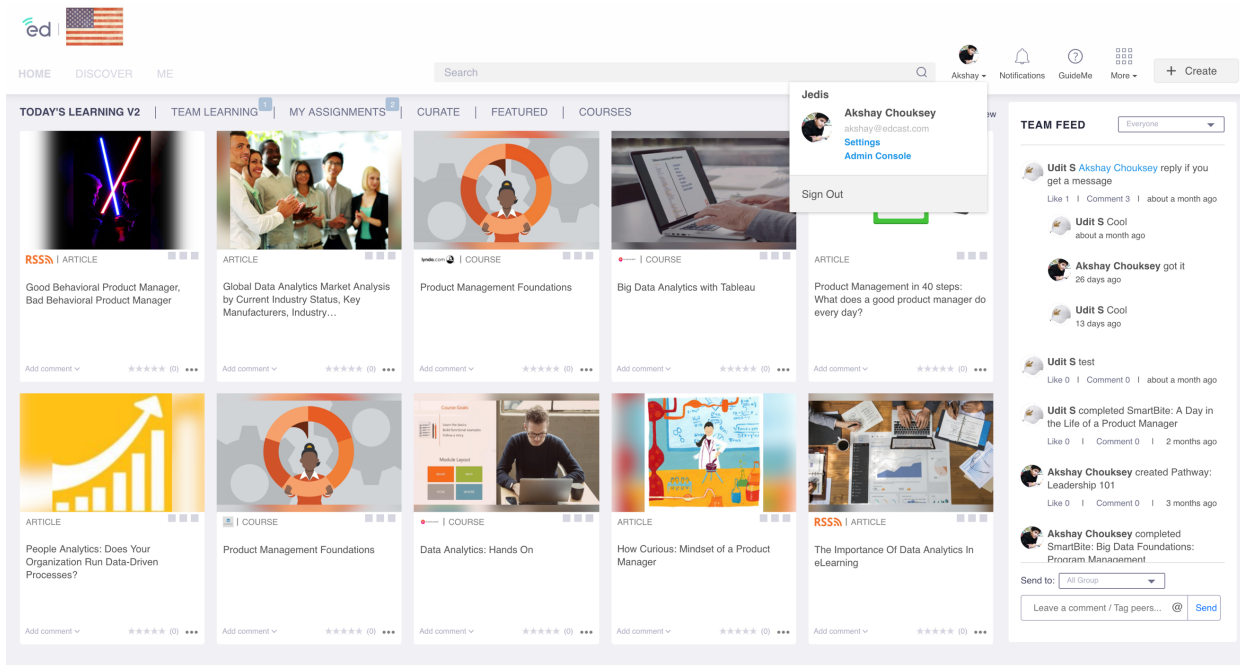


EdCast – LinkedIn Learning Integration:

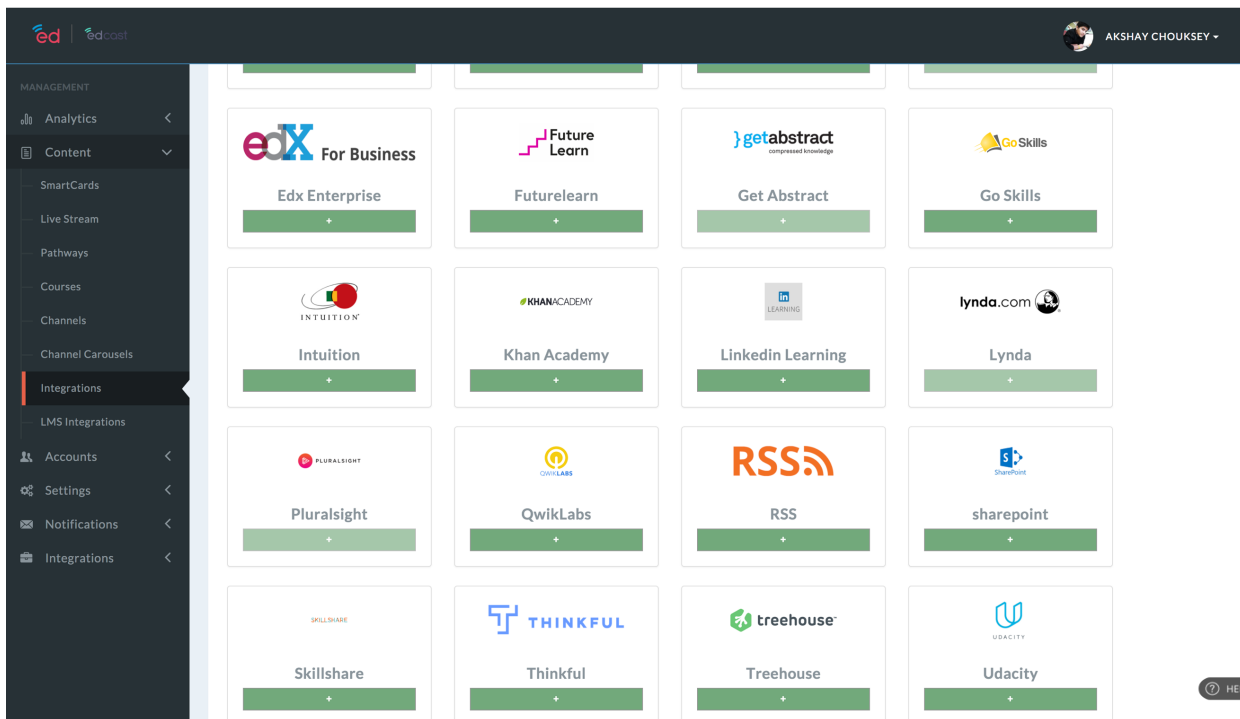

Enabling the Integration:

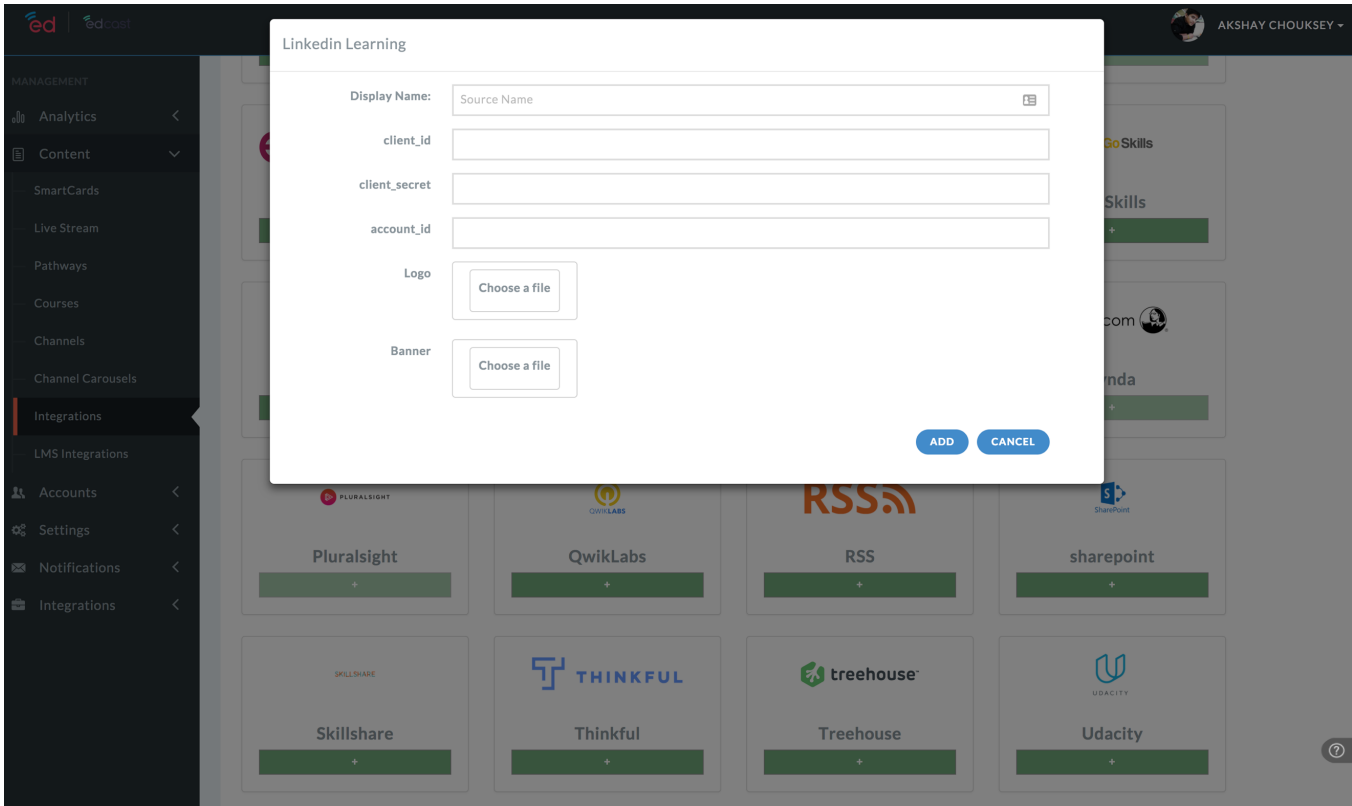
Step 1:

All the integrations can be managed by admin panel -> Content -> Integrations



Step 2:

For LinkedIn Learning, each client will have their own Client_id, secret, and ID which can be used to connect their respective LinkedIn Learning account.



Step 3:

Once the credentials are provided, the integration will be showed in bottom, which then can be sorted and featured as to be shown on UI

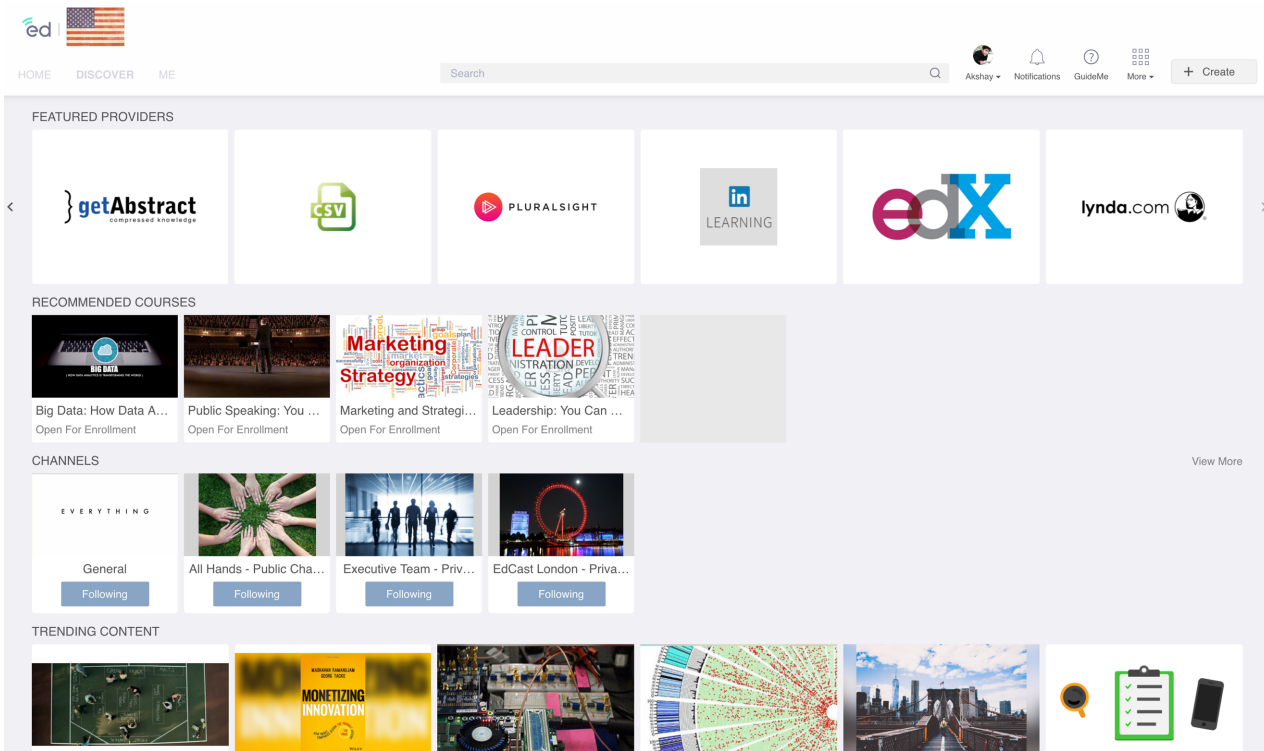

Accessing the content:

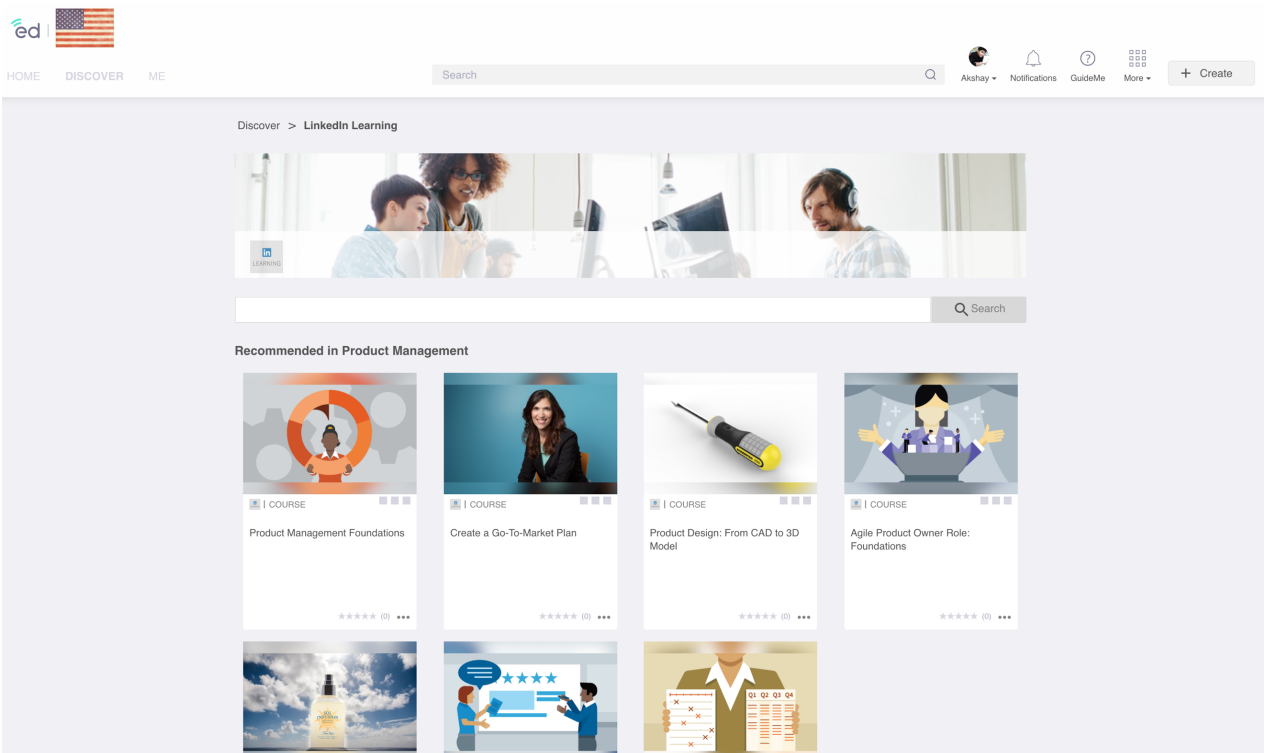
Step 1:

Once the integration is enabled, LinkedIn Learning icon will be available under Discover -> Featured Providers.



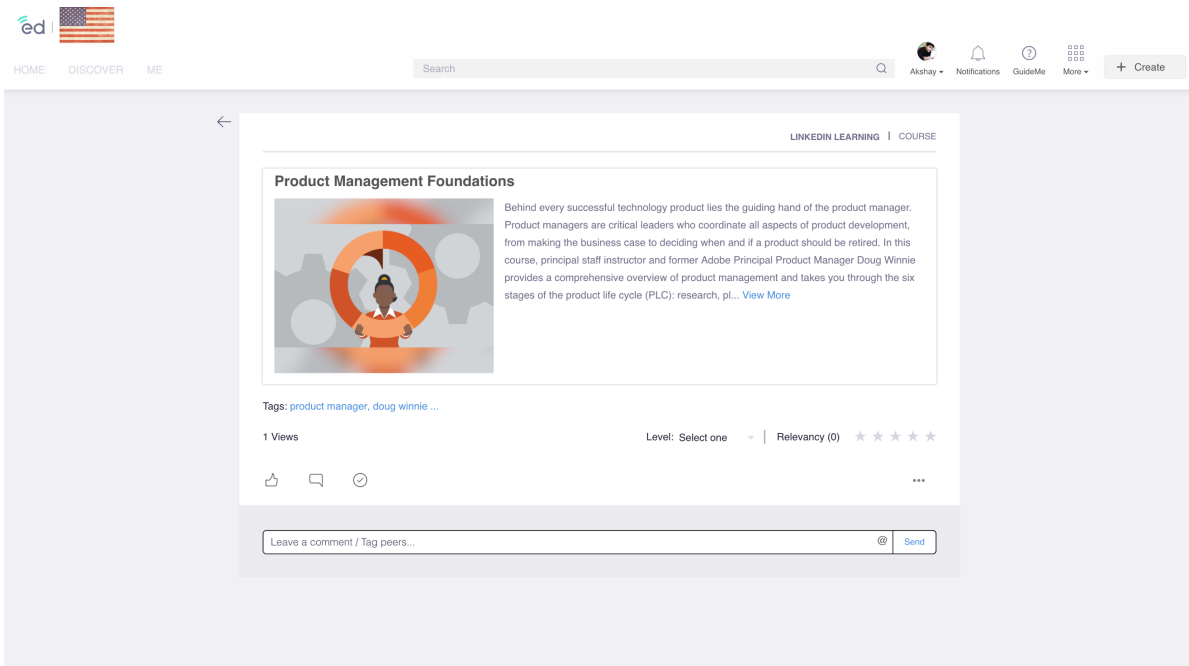
Step 2:
