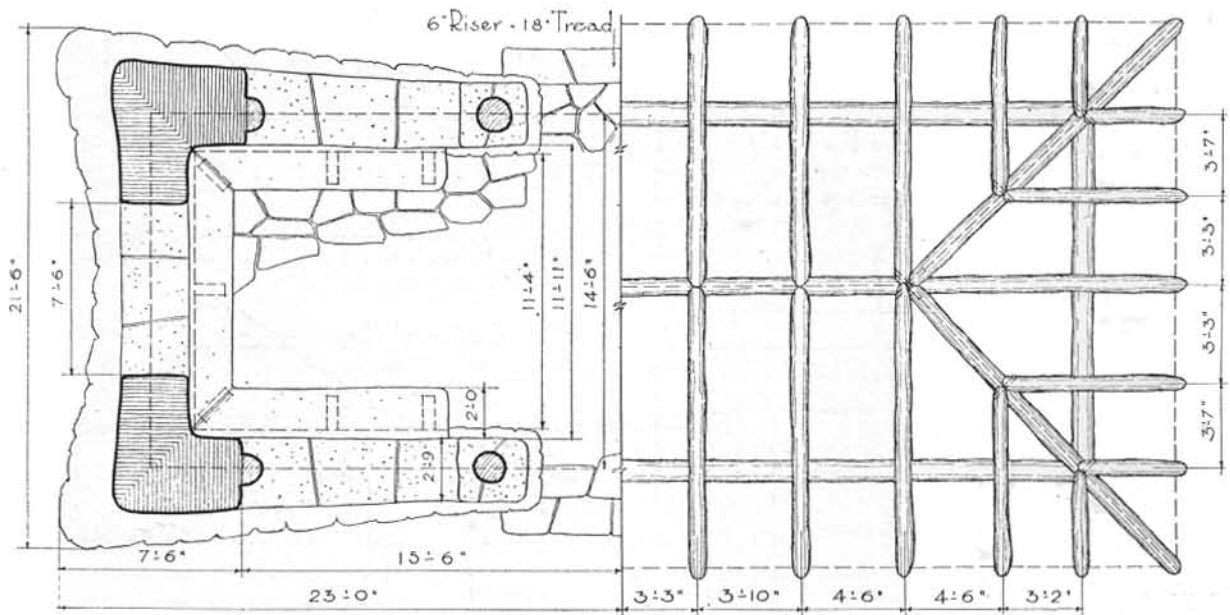




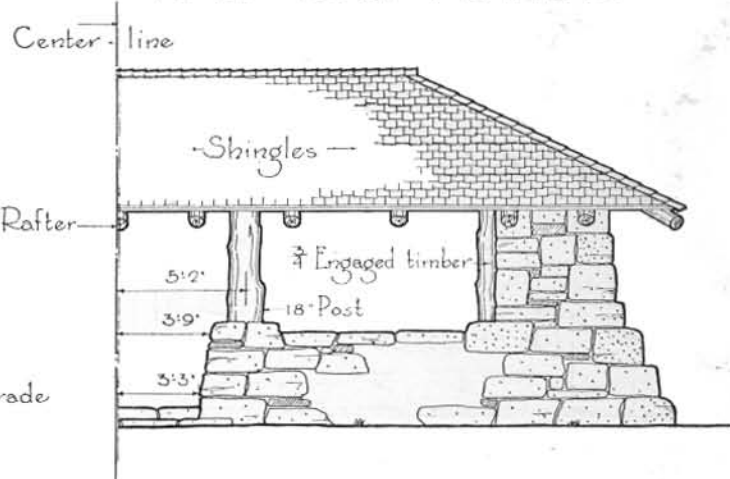
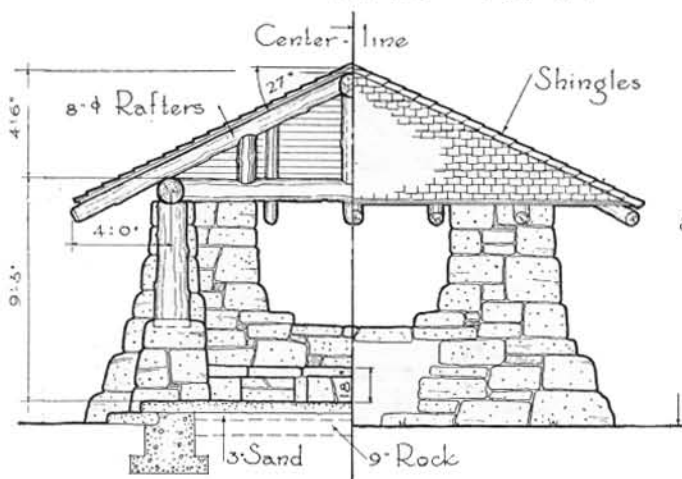
Shelter - Turner Falls State Park - Oklahoma

The free-hand lines of the shingle courses doubled every fourth or fifth course for scale and accent, the well-scaled pole rafter ends, the rugged informality and textural quality of the stone work, the batter of the wall - all combine to the success of this structure.
