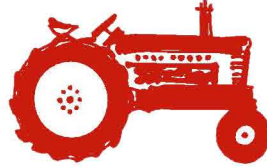
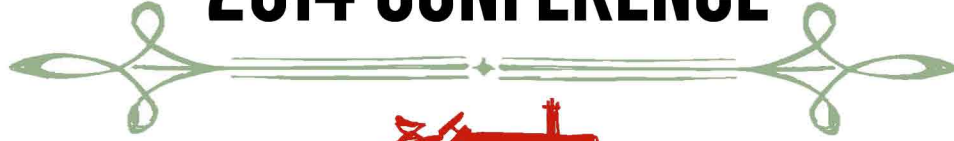


# SOUTH GEORGIA GROWING LOCAL 2014 CONFERENCE
