The user controls receive keyboard focus in the same tab order in which they are presented visually. Partner Relationship Management uses semantically correct markup, ensuring that the markup matches the visual presentation of content on the page. However, there are a few exceptions: The keyboard focus order is not correctly provided within the "Permission Sets - PAM" page. The keyboard focus order is not correctly provided in the "Manage Partner Channel", "Search for a Record", and "Register a Deal - CTW" modals within the "PRM for Slack App" page. The keyboard focus order is not correctly provided in the "New partner channel" modal dialog window. The keyboard focus order is not correctly provided in the Leads List view within the Leads with Scores page.
