Evaluation Methods Used:	Conformance to the listed accessibility standards has been evaluated using a combination of static analysis tools and manual testing with assistive technologies. The following operating system, browsers, toolsets, and screen readers are used for evaluation: JAWS 2023 with Chrome (latest) on Windows, NVDA with Firefox (latest) on Windows, VoiceOver with Chrome on MacOS (latest) (spot check), manual accessibility testing, and keyboard testing with visual focus. Testing included a representative sample of different pages, states, and content types.
