02 Challenge

Developing a robust and highly secure digital service

The Pontifical Swiss Guard needed devices with a digital solution that would not only be tough enough for daily use in the field but would also thoroughly protect their communications and allow them to operate at maximum efficiency with no risk.

A robust device: The devices will be used in the field and therefore needed to be rugged enough to last despite hard wear and tear.

Configurable: The devices are used for a highly specialised purpose and needed to be completely configurable to do that in the most efficient manner possible.

Secure: Most importantly, the devices needed to maintain the privacy of Pontifical Swiss Guard communications and protect any information contained therein.

We now have more robust tablets, which means fewer repairs and fewer devices that need to be replaced.

03 Solution

After evaluating their needs, it was determined that a combination of Galaxy Tab Active series and Knox Suite would give the Pontifical Swiss Guard the security and flexibility to carry out their duties more effectively.

The Samsung Galaxy Tab Active series are the ideal devices for the guards, as they come with either IP67 or IP68 ratings for water and dust protection*. In addition, the touch screen allows guards to operate their devices even if their gloves get wet**.

Knox Suite was chosen as the seamless device setup, and granular and comprehensive device management allows the Pontifical Swiss Guard to configure those devices as necessary, removing all apps that might be a distraction and including only the custom-made apps required for the job, boosting productivity.

Knox Suite also boosts security of the devices allowing the Pontifical Swiss Guard to meet all their compliance and safety requirements and protect their communications.
