In Memory Of Puddin Broome

South Point High School lost one of its biggest supporters of the athletic program, particularly baseball, when Puddin Broome died March 13 this year at the age of 67.

Broome was not only a strong supporter of athletics, but in school activities in general. Puddin coached countless hundreds of young baseball players over the years as an assistant to both Phil Tate and Mickey Lineberger at South Point.

A trophy in his name will be presented annually to the most improved player in baseball at South Point.

Football coach and athletic director Jim Biggerstaff said after his death, "He was one of the finest gentlemen I've ever known. He was more than just a baseball coach. Losing him is like losing a member of our coaching staff. He was that close to us."

Puddin will be missed by not only South Point High School, but by countless hundreds of other people in the community whose lives he touched.

From 1977 until 1979 Randy was athletic trainer for football, basketball, and baseball. He attended U.N.C.G. trainer clinic two summers during this time.

After graduation in 1979, Randy attended U.N.C.C. and was trainer for the basketball team under Coach Pratt and Coach Bartley. Even while at U.N.C.C. he remained a trainer for South Point.

As if he had never graduated, today, Randy continues his same position. He is faithful to the necessary and sometimes thankless tasks of attending athletic injuries and of cleaning all football uniforms after the games--- even to the late night hours. Randy can't find enough to do, so he works full time for Lineberger's Fish Fry, is an auxiliary policeman in Cramerton, and is active in his church.

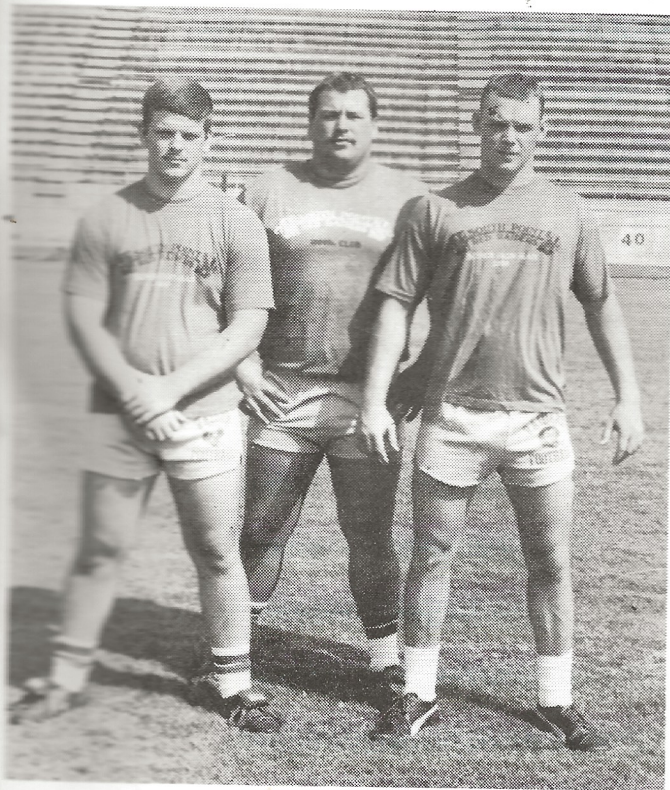

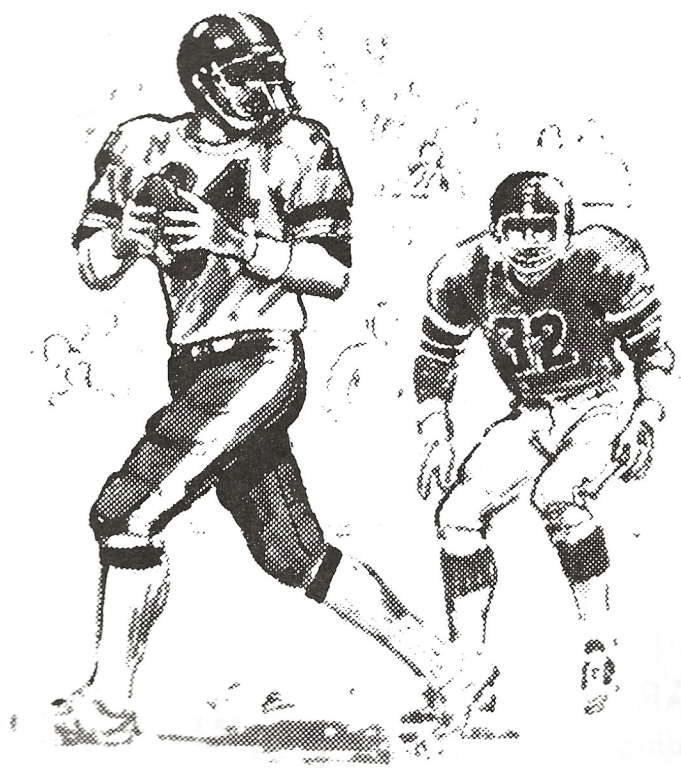
