All UCI Teams can manage their entries within their individual accounts. National Federations can also manage federation accounts and privateer riders will need to register with their National Federation first, payment then can be made online.

All riders must hold a valid (in date) UCI licence issued by their National Federation.

ACCREDITATION & DISCLAIMERS

03.5 TEAM AND RIDER EVENT ACCREDITATION

UCI Elite and Standard MTB teams will receive their season passes in Mairiporã as the first UCI World Cup of the year. Season passes are distributed for the 2024 season.

Individual riders not on a UCI Team will receive one bracelet at rider confirmation for themselves and one supporter to access the event free of charge during training and competition days.

03.6 INSURANCE

Personal insurance coverage is not provided by the WBDS/Organisers.

Racers are responsible for securing their own accident, rescue, health, travel, property and liability insurance.

Racers should have the following insurance coverage:

- Bodily injury (in and out-patient hospital expenses and medical care, emergency rescue and medical transport costs, permanent disablement, death) and material damages (loss of earnings) in case of accident in the course of the Event or during training
- Third-party liability insurance for material damage or bodily injury caused to others in the course of the Event or during training.

03.7 DISCLAIMER AND LIABILITY RELEASE

Racers voluntarily assume full and complete responsibility for all risks associated with participating in the Event and for any injury, accident or damage that may occur during their participation in the Event, including by way of example and not limitation: (a) travelling to and from the Event; (b) falls; (c) mechanical failures of equipment; (d) collisions with other participants, spectators and fixed or moving objects; (e) the effects of weather, including temperature extremes; (f) use of chairlifts, gondola or shuttle vehicles; (g) traffic accidents; (h) trail and road conditions; and (i) the negligence of themselves and/or others.

04.3 TRAINING

TRAINING SCHEDULE: Please refer to [the schedule in 2.1.](#)

All riders must display their handlebar number during training sessions.

A coach of a national team, UCI Elite MTB Team or UCI MTB teams must request a handlebar number, must hold a licence and wear a helmet.

Team plates will be allocated at rider confirmation and will not exceed the following allocation.

- UCI Elite MTB Team – 2 Team Plates
- UCI MTB Team – 1 Team Plate
- National Federations – 1 Team Plate (The top 5 ranked nations at the start of the 2024 season will have a second plate made available)

The course will be closed for TV inspection on a day to be confirmed in the schedule.

The course will be closed for UCI inspection on a day to be confirmed in the schedule.

04.4 TIMING CHIP COLLECTION

Timing system: [Chronorace](#)

Racers must carry their Timing Chips on their bike.

Timing Chips can be collected between 90 - 30 minutes before the start of each race and available from the Timing tent on the day of the race.

All riders are responsible for the return of their transponder in the finish area. Any non-returned transponder will be invoiced 100 euros.

05.1 TEAM AREA ACCESS

Ahead of arrival, please contact Regina Barbieri on regina@mtbfestival.com.br / +55 21990 073083. You will need to detail the following.

- Exact arrival time
- Vehicle registration plate
- Names of staff arriving to set up team paddock

Arrival location: You will need to enter the IMTB Arena [HERE \(What 3 Words\)](#) at P4 and follow the track to the first check-point. When you arrive at the gate, a member of the Mairiporã team will guide you to your space.

All teams must arrive by **Thursday at 12:00 (local time)**, any late arrivals will incur a €1,000 penalty fine. Any teams wishing to cancel their paddock space must inform cycling.teams@wbd.com by 17:00 Wednesday 10th April.

Any early departure requests must be pre-approved by WBD Sports, please email cycling.teams@wbd.com to submit a request.








A medical team will be in attendance during all official practice and competition times.

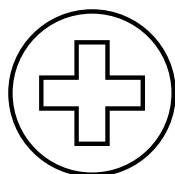

07.4. MEDICAL AND CONCUSSION PROTOCOL

WBD & the UCI are committed to improving rider safety & ensuring that athletes taking part in our events receive the highest standard of medical care possible. One area where we want to ensure consistency across all MTB disciplines at our events is the identification of potential rider head injury / concussion events & the subsequent assessment & medical diagnosis of concussions where necessary.

MEDICAL

The UCI have a [concussion protocol](#) & we will, in conjunction with the LOC appointed medical team, be applying this protocol across all disciplines during training & races. Any rider who has an incident which could result in a head injury / concussion & is then asked to undergo a concussion assessment by a member of the event medic team must comply with this request. Likewise, any rider or team manager who suspects a concussion should refer themselves or their athlete to the event medical team as soon as possible. A positive diagnosis of concussion by a medical professional may result in that athlete being withdrawn from competition.

07.5 LOCAL INFORMATION

It is advised you check the travel advise from your government regarding travel in Brazil.

Yellow Fever and Dengue Fever is currently an issue locally and it is advised athletes and staff should come prepared with mosquito repellent.

It is advised to wear long sleeve shirts and full-length lightweight trousers during the day.

The heat in Brazil has been very hot, please come prepared with plenty of sun cream.
