bet, .green, .lgbt, .organic, .poker, .vote, .voto,

The following additional provisions apply to the domain names that are registered through the various registries.

.BET and .POKER

For the .BET and .POKER TLDs, Registrants acknowledge and agree to provide administrative contact information, which must be kept up-to-date, for the notification of complaints or reports of registration abuse, as well as the contact details of the relevant regulatory, or industry self regulatory, bodies in their main place of business.

.LGBT

Registrants of Names in the .LGBT Top Level Domain (TLD) are responsible to ensure that such Names are at all times registered and used in compliance with all applicable national, federal, regional, state and local laws, ordinances and regulations ("Applicable Laws"), including, without limitation, applicable laws relating to hate speech, discrimination and other such activities.

Registrants are prohibited from using the .LGBT domain in a manner that is harmful, threatening, abusive, harassing, defamatory, or hateful with respect to the LGBT community. Domain names that are likely to deceive, disparage or cause a material detriment to the LGBT community are explicitly prohibited (e.g., ihate.lgbt, anti.lgbt, etc.).

In addition to any other rights of the Registry Operator ("Registry") existing under the Registry-Registrar Agreement between the Registry and any applicable registrar or otherwise, the Registry reserves the right to deny or cancel the registration, renewal, or transfer of any Registered Name; or to place any Registered Name on registry lock, hold, or similar status, with respect to any such Registered Name that the Registry, upon reasonable belief formed after reasonable investigation, deems to be registered or used in a manner that constitutes a violation of the .LGBT Acceptable Use Policy.

.ORGANIC

Anyone can register a .ORGANIC domain. However, if content on the Registrant's website is related to the following industries, the Registrant will need to make sure that the content falls within the guidelines of IFOAM Organics International's Principles of Organic Agriculture (https://www.ifoam.bio/en/organicandmarks/principles-organic-agriculture)

Examples include:

- 1. Certified organic producers, farmers, distributors and the like;
- 2. Certified organic textile and skincare providers;
- 3. Organic restaurants and venues;
- 4. Certifiers in the organic community;
- 5. Publications, journalists and bloggers catering to the organic community and industry;
- Non-profit, not-for-profit and trade associations that primarily serve and represent the organic community.

.VOTE

Registrants must have a bona fide intention to use the domain name, during the current/relevant election cycle, in connection with a clearly identified political/democratic process at the time of registration. Warehousing domain names for future speculative use, or registering a domain name to principally block the bona fide registration and use by a third party is expressly prohibited.

Name Selection

Registry Operator has initially identified the following non-exclusive domain name classifications and restrictions for Registrants when registering a domain name in the TLD.

Standard Registrations

There must be a clear and logical nexus between the activities of the Registrant within the political/democratic system and the domain name being registered. .VOTO

Registrants must have a bona fide intention to use the domain name, during the current/relevant election cycle, in connection with a clearly identified political/democratic process at the time of registration. Warehousing domain names for future speculative use, or registering a domain name to principally block the bona fide registration and use by a third party is expressly prohibited.

Registry Operator has initially identified the following non-exclusive domain name classifications and restrictions for Registrants when registering a domain name in the TLD.

Standard Registrations

.VOTO requires that accurate Registrant data is available in the WHOIS at all times. Therefore, Proxy / Private Registration is not allowed in .VOTO registrations.

.GREEN

Registrant agrees to adhere to the operational standards, policies, procedures, and practices for the Registry TLD established from time to time by Registry Operator in a non-arbitrary manner and applicable to all registrars, found at http://nic.green/registrars/policies/, including affiliates of Registry Operator, and consistent with ICANN's standards, policies, procedures, and practices and the Registry Agreement.

Registrant agrees to adhere to those public interest commitments (as set forth in Specification 11 to the Registry Agreement, as amended from time to time), community registration policies (as set forth in Specification 12 to the Registry Agreement, as amended from time to time) and Government Advisory Committee ("GAC") safeguards (as set forth in Exhibit B to the Registry-Registrar Agreement or otherwise published or provided to the Registrant from time to time).
