all actively involved in research and development of
natural products and phytomedicines.


Every year, the society holds an Annual Convention,
and once every four years, it hosts an International Conference
to bring together the ideas of scientists and
academicians engaged in pharmacognosy and
natural product research.

JAMIA HAMDARD

‘Committed to Excellence in Higher Education’

Jamia Hamdard (JH), established by Founder-Chancellor Hakeem Abdul Hameed, was declared a deemed-to-be University by the Government of India in 1989, following the recommendation of the University Grants Commission (UGC) under the UGC Act of 1956. This recognition was granted in acknowledgment of the services provided by the educational institutes founded by the Hamdard National Foundation (HNF). These institutes, developed over time, include the Hamdard College of Pharmacy, Hamdard Tibbi College, Rifaida College of Nursing, the Institute of History of Medicine & Medical Research, and the Indian Institute of Islamic Studies.





The University has received special grants, including the PURSE (Promotion of University Research in Science and Engineering) grant, and more recently, Rs. 10 crore from the AYUSH Ministry under the Centre for Excellence Scheme. Additionally, it has been generously funded under the STUTI, a scheme by the Department of Science and Technology (DST).

JH was ranked 2nd in h-index values and 5th in i10-index values according to SCOPUS data among all the institutes awarded the DST PURSE grant.

Its publications have received an average of over 16 citations per paper, the second-highest in India. The h-index of JH exceeds 100, and its i10-index is 100. Approximately 38% of its publications have been cited at least 10 times, according to the SCOPUS database.

JH maintains a close relationship with the Defence Research and Development Organisation (DRDO), and joint research between JH and INMAS-DRDO has led to the development of pharmaceutical products now used by the defense forces.

The School of Pharmaceutical Education & Research (SPER), formerly known as the Faculty of Pharmacy, was established as Hamdard College of Pharmacy in 1972. It is one of the most prestigious institutions for pharmaceutical education in India, recognized for its global standards. SPER has consistently ranked among the top institutions by the National Institutional Ranking Framework (NIRF), achieving the No. 1 position in 2019, 2020, 2021, 2022, and 2024, and No. 2 in 2023, as per the Ministry of Education, Government of India.

SPER is approved and recognized by the Pharmacy Council of India (PCI).

It continues to build on its legacy of excellence by offering high-quality pharmacy education in India. The School is a hub of academic and research excellence in pharmaceutical sciences. Our modern infrastructure, combined with an experienced faculty,

has been instrumental in producing world-class pharmacy professionals for industry, academia, and research institutions worldwide. The School also maintains collaborations with external academic and research institutions, as well as pharmaceutical industries.

A dedicated pharmacy block, focused on advanced research in fields such as Formulation Research and Nanomedicine, Neurobehavioral Pharmacology, Microbial and Pharmaceutical Biotechnology, Bioactive Natural Products, and Drug Design and Medicinal Chemistry, is an integral part of the School. This facility is equipped with state-of-the-art technology to support cutting-edge research.



Department of Pharmacognosy and Phytochemistry

The Department is actively involved in the discovery and development of herbal drugs, phytopharmaceuticals, and microbial products; quality control of herbal and microbial products, as well as botanicals, through the analysis of principal components, markers, and fingerprinting; and the enhanced production of secondary metabolites through fermentation technology.

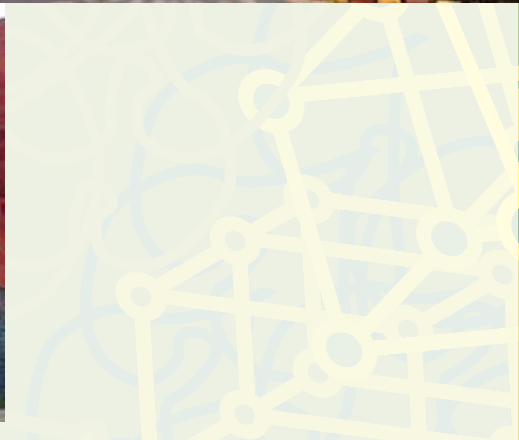
