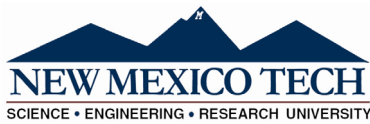

### JOB SUMMARY:

This position is responsible for providing network support to administrative and academic users of with a variety of physical and virtual PC software, hardware, security and network services. Also supports network printers, scanners, IP telephones and other networked devices

Supports the configuration, installation, monitoring, and operation of the wireless infrastructure.

Supervise staff as well as student workers.
