- Ongoing research as system is changing / novel
- Include economics & governance in assessment and advice
- Develop and apply suitable models to address key questions, e.g. spatial processes or compliance
- Higher scientific credits to stock assessment



My main points

- Need to better link science to assessment & advice
- Include fisheries sector as partner, e.g. self-sampling
- Adaptive (regional) management needed
- Good communication of scientific facts – but also of uncertainties
