RULES FOR ACADEMIC DISCIPLINE

1. The student must register himself/ herself on date and time as notified by the college. In case of failure his/her BONAFIDE STATUS IN THE COLLEGE WILL BE CANCELLED. In order to revive the bonafide status he/she will be required to seek re-admission as per prevalent procedure.
2. Every student is required to attend all the lectures, practical and other co-curricular activities. The attendance is condoned up to 25% on medical ground and other genuine reasons beyond the control of students. Thus, the student enrolled is required to register 75% attendance to become eligible to appear in the sessional tests and End Semester Theory and Practical Examinations.
3. A student, remaining absent for more than 15 days without prior written permission of the HOD/Dean/Director, is liable to be removed from the College and his/her name will be struck-off from the rolls.
4. Every student must appear in all the tests, complete all assignments including tutorial and project work etc., given by different teachers within the specified time period. Students should bear in mind that internal assessment marks are based on their performance in these academically indispensable aspects and any failure in this regard would be deemed expedient for the student concerned.
5. Evaluation of performance in tests, tutorials, assignments and project work as well as attendance record shall be made by the faculty for the purpose of award of internal assessment marks. Such marks awarded by the faculty would be final and binding subject to modulation by Dean/Director and no complaint in this regard shall be entertained.
6. Late entry and interim/early departure from classroom, lab etc. are strictly prohibited.
7. All students must be inside the lecture halls/laboratories during lecture hours and lab sessions. Roaming in the corridors, the cafeteria, or any other part of the campus during lectures/tutorials/practical amounts to serious violation of academic code of conduct.
8. Students are not allowed to engage in sports/games or any other activities during lectures/tutorials/practical classes.

RULES FOR GENERAL DISCIPLINE

1. Students are always required to carry their I-Cards.
2. Mobile phones and any other personal electronic gadgets must be switched off in academic domains during any kind of curricular/co-curricular activity.
3. Eatables, tea, coffee, soft drinks or other such items cannot be consumed during academic engagements and in academic places, including classrooms, labs, library, corridors, stair-cases and other areas of this sort. Students must learn and strictly observe normal decency, decorum, guidelines and rules of the Academic Institution on a daily basis.

LEAVE PROCEDURE FOR STUDENTS

Hostellers are required to take prior permission from HOD/Academic Coordinator before going on leave and submit the application to Hostel Warden and also provide a copy to their respective Counselors. Day scholars not able to attend college due to some emergency should submit leave application signed by their parent and counter signed by HOD to their respective Counselors. No student is allowed to be absent from college without proper leave application.

UNIFORM AND ETIQUETTES

1. Students must adhere to prescribed / decent dress-code befitting the dignity of technical / professional students at all times within the college premises.
2. Only formals are allowed to all the students until they get their uniform from the institute.
3. Casuals/ jeans/ slippers are not allowed in academic blocks or library.
4. Wishing/Greeting members of Management, Faculty and Staff of the College with due respect for them.
5. Being courteous and polite in dealing with all staff-members and employees.
6. Observing silence and/or speaking in soft and low voice in and around the library, laboratories and office of the Director, the Deans, HODs, Senior Officials, faculty rooms and corridors of the academic building. It must be noted that shouting, talking loudly or in chorus, using indecent, abusive and discourteous language anywhere within the college premises are considered as serious act of indiscipline and punishable as per recommendations of the Disciplinary Committee.
7. Being considerate and helpful to fellow students and human beings.
8. Not issuing any public or press statement, sending letters to editors, Government, public servants or notaries without prior permission and approval of the Director, in writing.
9. Students are not allowed to squat on the parapet walls and engage in gossiping, making noise, and any other untoward activity.
10. Keeping the status, dignity, prestige and reputation of your alma-mater, i.e. IMSEC, high and not engaging in anything that might directly or indirectly undermine the standing of the College.

ATTENDANCE CRITERIA

1. **Attendance:** Attendance of each Class/Lab/Tutorial will be marked on ERP Portal and register. In case of mass bunk, all students will be marked absent. All faculty members should submit weekly absentee report to the HOD/Academic Coordinator.

As per AKTU norms, a minimum of 75% attendance (60% with Director's approval, only in case of pre-approved medical leave) is required to make students eligible to appear in end semester University examination.

Our target is to achieve 95% average attendance in every subject.

2. **Detained:** Students will be debarred from appearing in ST(Sessional Test)/CTs (Cumulative Tests) on the basis of attendance as per the following criteria:-
 - i.CT-I Students whose average attendance is below 70% and late reporting students.
 - ii.CT-II Students whose average attendance is below 75%.

Students having less than 75% average attendance if allowed to appear in CTs will have to give an undertaking that he/she will maintain minimum 75% average attendance in future classes.

STUDENT SUPPORT

1. If any student has subject related query, he/she should maintain the following hierarchy-
subject teacher→ subject coordinator→ Academic coordinator→ HoD→Dean academics→ Director.
2. If any student has any common query, he/she should maintain the following hierarchy-
Mentor→ Class coordinator→ HoD→ Director.
3. If any student has university related query, he/she should maintain the following hierarchy-
Mentor→ HoD→ Registrar→ Director.
4. **If any student has hostel related query, he/she should maintain the following hierarchy-
Hostel Warden→ Chief Warden→ Mentor→ HoD→ Director.**

ANTI-RAGGING RULES & REGULATIONS

1. Ragging of fresher or any other fellow student is a serious act of indiscipline and has been totally banned by the Hon'ble Supreme Court. Anyone found involved in any form of ragging, verbal or physical, inside or outside the college campus, hostels or buses will not be spared. Such cases would immediately be handed over to Police. If any student is found indulged in ragging, he/she will be removed from the roll of college/rusticated.
2. Students must not get involved in quarreling or fighting or any indecent verbal or physical activity among themselves, the staff and faculty or visitors. Direct or indirect involvement in any such activity will be considered as serious breach of discipline and strict disciplinary action will be taken against erring students.

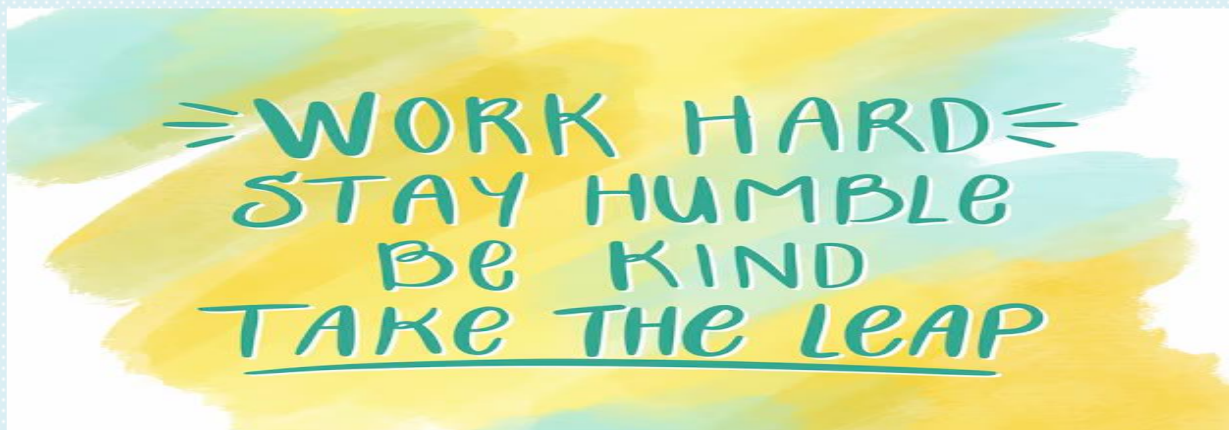
