4. **Notification for Competitions at Other Colleges:** If students are representing Indraprastha College for Women in competitions or events hosted by other institutions, they are required to take permission from the respective department and college authorities in advance. This ensures proper coordination and support from the college.

5. **Mindful Content Creation:** Students must be mindful of the messages conveyed through all presentations, performances, or any form of content creation. Content should be respectful, inclusive, and align with the values of diversity and equality upheld by our institution.
