M. A. in Peace and Conflict Studies (New Course)

Peace and Conflict Studies is a research based interdisciplinary programme of the School. It broadly aims to provide students advance expertise in the theoretical postulates of peace and conflicts besides case analysis. The programme draws upon the collective academic expertise of Centre for Federal Studies and Department of Islamic Studies.

Duration: Two Years (4 Semesters).

Seats: 25

Eligibility: 45% marks in aggregate in the Bachelors examination recognized by the Statutory Bodies of India.

Selection Procedure: On the basis of merit determined by marks in the respective qualifying examination (up to 4th semester for 3 year programme).

Employment Opportunities: Students are expected to serve as experts to the national and international agencies engaged in the field of peace building and conflict resolutions. They may have opportunity to serve as policy consultants to state and other autonomous bodies, besides building career in academics.

Annual Course Fee (for Indian Students): Rs. 20,000/-

Five Year Integrated/Blended Degree Programme in B.A. (Hons.) and M.A. in Politics and Economics (New Course)

Probably the first blended degree programme offered by any Indian University, the course has been uniquely designed to develop a rigorous and analytical understanding among the students in the **Applied and Core Domains of Politics (Political Science) and Economics**. Needless to mention that twenty first century Social sciences are moving fast towards an inter/trans/multidisciplinary studies of the complex process of decisions and policy making. It requires a blended application of the unique and critical strengths of each discipline. Intrinsically related disciplines coalesce to produce an effective and integrated perspective to a common problem. Political Science and Economics are two correlated disciplines which are distinctively engaged in deconstructing *THE PUBLIC*.

Essentially a research based degree programme, the course provides in-depth knowledge of contemporary advances in the fields of Political Science and Economics. Students will be given strong understanding in the theories, ideologies and methodologies of politics and economics, besides skilling them in the institutional and structural dimensions of political and economic decisions. Applied aspects include society and political processes, political psychology, political sociology, political economy/public finance, micro/macroeconomics, behavioral and experimental economics, public choice, politics and economics of public policies including health, environment, energy, cultural politics and economics, alternative paradigms of developments etc.

Design and Exit Option

1. It is five years (10 Semesters) integrated programme. After successful conclusion of three years (06 Semesters), students will have **option to exit the course with a degree in Bachelor of Arts (Hons.) in Politics and Economics**.
2. **In the fifth year of the course, students will have option to elect advance specialization either in the field of Politics or Economics. This will be reflected in his/her degree.**

Seats: 50

Eligibility: Admission will be offered on the basis of merit of first five subjects in the qualifying examination (i.e. **plus two level**) conducted by statutory bodies/boards of India.

Career Opportunities: After successful conclusion of the course, students, besides academics, will have career opportunities in public and private sectors, national and international agencies engaged in policy planning and implementation, besides exclusive career in academics.

M.A (Public Policy and Governance)

Unique Strength

During last three decades public policy studies the world over have moved away from being a technocratic science to a deliberative system examining the critical relationships between people, polity and economy. The new science of public policy draws considerable strengths from narrative structures, contestations and engagements of people with governance system. To put differently, public policy study is not merely an exercise into quantifying outcome through statistical designs and empirical data, but also a qualitative measure of paradigms and theory building. It is in this aspect that the present course **benchmarks** itself from other courses in public policy. Most significantly, designed course seeks to train students and stake holders both in the fields of policy designs and governance models. This in a way is departure from hitherto approach to public policy studies. Most of the institutions engaged in public policy studies follow a quantitative approach, whereas the present course lays significant emphasis on qualitative measures of policy analysis, paradigm development and concepting data into grand theory of public policy.

Last semester offers elective advance specialisation in select important sectors of public policies in India such as welfare of marginised groups, minority welfare and development, welfare of women and children, language promotion and development policy, education policy, tribal development and ethnic accommodation, labour and employment policy, food and nutrition policy, natural resource management and development policy, industrial development policy, environmental, climate change and disaster management policy, power and energy policy, science and technology policy, health policy and agriculture development policy.

Duration: Two Years (4 Semesters)

Seats: 25

Eligibility: 45% marks in aggregate in the Bachelors examination recognized by the Statutory Bodies of India.

Selection Procedure: On the basis of merit determined by marks in the respective qualifying examination (up to 4th semester for 3 year programme).

Employment Destinations:

Students are expected to emerge as specialised experts of policy planning and governance. As far as employability is concerned, this course will enable them to get employed not only in academia, but also in the professional fields such as national and international organisations, think tanks and bureaucracy. They will have ample opportunity to serve as policy consultants/ advisors/ and analysts

M.A (Human Rights)

Designed to develop critical understanding of the theories and practices (national and international) of human rights, the programme uniquely blends intellectual strengths of social sciences, law, and science and technology. Students are also encouraged to do internships in the premier institutions and NGOs engaged in the protection, promotion and development of human rights in India.

Duration: Two Years (4 Semesters)

Seats: 25

Eligibility: 45% marks in aggregate in the Bachelors examination recognized by the Statutory Bodies of India.

Selection Procedure: On the basis of merit determined by marks in the respective qualifying examination (up to 4th semester for 3 year programme).

Employment Opportunities: Passed out students are engaged in teaching & research, NGOs, PSUs and other national and international agencies.

Annual Course Fee (for Indian Students): Rs. 20,000/-

Course Fee for NRI and Foreign Nationals: \$ 4000/-

Department/Centre: Centre for Federal Studies

M. Phil. (Federal Studies)

M.Phil is a pre-Ph.D but a separate programme. Candidates for admission to M.Phil. programme shall have a Master's Degree in the major disciplines of Social Sciences/ Federal Studies such as Political Science, International Politics, Economics, Public Finance, Public Policy, Governance, Regional and Development Studies, Geography, Sociology, Public Administration, Human Rights, Law, Comparative Politics and other allied disciplines, or a Professional degree declared equivalent to Master's degree by the corresponding statutory body, with at least 55% marks in aggregate or its equivalent grade 'B' in the UGC 7-points scale.

The Course has been restructured:

1. To impart the best traditions of social science research
2. To train students in the methods and techniques of conducting research
3. To train students in the art and science of interpretation and discourse analysis
4. To equip students with disciplinary methods of federal studies
5. To develop advance specialization in the realms of federal studies and public policy
6. To train students in the art of publishing quality papers

Seats: 25

Selection criteria: M.Phil. programme shall be for a minimum duration of two consecutive semesters/ one year, including course work and to a maximum of four consecutive semesters/ two years.

Selection will be based on performance in interview and previous academic record as per the following:

Ph.D. in Federal Studies

Eligibility: Candidates shall have a Master's Degree or a professional degree declared equivalent to Master's degree by the corresponding statutory body, with at least 55% marks in aggregate or its equivalent Grade 'B' in the UGC 7-point scale. NET-JRF/Individual Fellowship holders/Project Fellows will be preferred for admissions in Ph.D. programs.

Note: University reserves right to amend eligibility and selection process/criteria from time to time.

DEPARTMENT OF ISLAMIC STUDIES

B.A (Honors) Islamic Studies

Duration: Three years (6 Semesters)

Seats: 25

Eligibility: A candidate must have passed the Senior Secondary (12th Standard/ Intermediate) examination conducted by the Central Board of Secondary Education, or any other examination recognized by Jamia Hamdard, securing at least 45% marks in aggregate. Knowledge of Urdu is essential. Alternatively, he/she should have passed *Alim* from state Madrasa Board or should have *Alimiyah* degree from Madrasas recognized by Jamia Hamdard, securing at least 45% marks.

Note: Candidates applying for B.A (Hons.) Islamic Studies are advised to read the list of Madrasas/Boards/Institutions recognized by Jamia Hamdard as mentioned in General Information and Admission Guidelines. It is further to be noted that the admission of Madrasa students with *Alimiyat* and *Fazilat* degrees is restricted to only B.A (Hons.) in Islamic Studies henceforth.

However, above eligibility is subject to any amendments and modifications made by the university from time to time.

Selection procedure: On the basis of merit of first five subjects in the respective qualifying examination.

Course Fee for NRI and Foreign Nationals: \$ 2000/-

Department/Centre: Department of Islamic Studies

M.A. (Islamic Studies)

Duration: Two years (4 Semesters)

Seats: 15 (Inclusive of reserved seats for NRI/Sponsored candidates), Additional seats are available for Foreign Nationals.

Eligibility: Candidate must have a Bachelor's degree in Islamic Studies or related disciplines (Theology or Arabic or Urdu or Persian) with at least **45%** marks.

Note: Candidates applying for M.A in Islamic Studies are advised to note that the admission of Madrasa students with *Alimiyat* and *Fazilat* degrees is restricted to only B.A (Hons.) in Islamic Studies henceforth.

However, above eligibility is subject to any amendments and modifications made by the university from time to time.

Selection procedure: On the basis of merit determined by marks in the respective qualifying examination (upto 4th semester for a 3 year programme).

Annual Course Fee (for Indian Students): Rs. 10,000/-

Course Fee for NRI and Foreign Nationals: \$ 3000/-

Department/Centre: Department of Islamic Studies

M.A in Sufism (New Course)

Besides in-depth analysis of the philosophy and practices of mysticism, the course broadly focuses on the study of Sufism in the light of Quran and Sunnah. It critically addresses to the question of ethics and peace in major Sufi writings, specialized study of Sufi traditions , autobiographical study of the life and works of famous Sufis, forms and practices of Bhakti movement, study of famous Sufi Silsilas (Schools of Thought) of India and South Asia, and other important dimensions of Sufism and Sufi studies.

Duration: Two Years (4 Semesters)

Seats: 25

Eligibility: 45% marks in aggregate in the Bachelors examination recognized by the Statutory Bodies of India or Fazil/Fazilat degree from Madrasas recognized by Jamia Hamdard.

Selection Procedure: On the basis of merit determined by marks in the respective qualifying examination (up to 4th semester for 3 year programme).

Employment Opportunities: Students will have job opportunities in the departments of Islamic Studies and Sufi Studies, in oriental studies libraries, and in the Madrasas recognized by state Madrasa Board

Course Fee for NRI and Foreign Nationals: \$ 4000/-

One Year Diploma Programme in Islam and Interfaith Relations (UG Level Programme) (New Course)

In the contemporary conflictual world, importance of interfaith relations and dialogue can hardly be overemphasised. Besides conceptual exploration and case analysis, the course explains in details the importance of Islamic perspective on pluralism, religious tolerations and co-livings of people of different faiths and identities, and to familiarize students about the inclusive and accommodative nature of Islamic traditions in multi-cultural societies such as India.

Duration: One Year (Two Semesters)

Seats: 25

Eligibility: Candidate must have passed the Senior Secondary (12th Standard/ Intermediate) examination conducted by the Statutory Bodies of India or has passed Alim/Alimiyah degree from Madrasas recognized by Jamia Hamdard, securing at least 45% marks.

Selection Procedure: On the basis of merit determined by marks in the respective qualifying examination.

Employment Opportunities: After successful conclusion of the course, students will have ample opportunities to be engaged by the agencies and institutions involved in peace-building, national security planning and interfaith dialogue.

Annual Course Fee (for Indian Students): Rs. 10,000/-

Course Fee for NRI and Foreign Nationals: \$ 1500/-

Department/Centre: Department of Islamic Studies

One Year Diploma Programme in Arabic Language

(UG level programme) (New Course)

Being a course in translational studies, students will learn Arabic grammatical structure, lexicographical system, vocabulary exchanges and calligraphies.

Duration: One Year (Two Semesters).

Seats: 25

Eligibility: Candidate must have passed the Senior Secondary (12th Standard/ Intermediate) examination conducted by the Statutory Bodies of India or has passed Alim /Alimiyah degree from Madrasas recognized by Jamia Hamdard, securing at least 45% marks.

Selection Procedure: On the basis of merit determined by marks in the respective qualifying examination.

Employment Opportunities: Needless to mention that students will be trained to serve as translators and interpretators in embassies, business establishments, government departments and other similar establishments.

Annual Course Fee (for Indian Students): Rs. 10,000/-

Course Fee for NRI and Foreign Nationals: \$ 1500/-

Department/Centre: Department of Islamic Studies

Ph.D. Islamic Studies

Eligibility and selection procedure: Candidates shall have a Master's Degree in Islamic Studies with at least 55% marks in aggregate or its equivalent Grade 'B' in the UGC 7-point scale.

NET-JRF/Individual Fellowship holders/Project Fellows will be preferred for admissions in Ph.D. programs.

Annual Course Fee (for Indian Students): Rs. 60,000/-
