Highlights of Budget 2007-08 (Textiles)

General

- 1. Education Cess hiked to 3% from 2%.
- 2. Peak rate of Customs duty on non agricultural goods has been reduced from 12.5% to 10%.
- 3. Central Sales Tax reduced from 4% to 3%.
- 4. All companies and firms with a taxable income of Rs. one crore or less has been exempted from surcharge on the income tax payable.

Customs

- 1. Customs duty on PSF, PFY and Polyester chips has been reduced from 10% to 7.5%.
- 2. Customs duty on DMT, PTA and MEG has been reduced from 10% to 7.5%.
- 3. Aramid yarns for manufacture of bulletproof jackets for supply to the Armed Forces have been exempted from both customs duty and Counter veiling duty.

Central Excise

- 1. Excise duty has been reduced from 16% to 12% on caprolactum, nylon chips and benzene for manufacture of caprolactum.
- 2. Optional excise duty at 12% has been prescribed for fishnet grade nylon yarn, nylon fishnet fabrics and fishnet.
- 3. Excise Duty exemption for 40 specified textile machinery under List 2 has been withdrawn and an excise duty of 8% has been imposed. However, excise duty exemption for 16 specified silk textile machinery under List 3 continues.
