

Transportation

Osaka Gakuin University is most easily reached from Osaka by either JR (Japan Railway) or Hankyu Railway.

1. By Train

(1) By JR

From Osaka station take a local train on the Kyoto Line in the direction of Kyoto

(from Shin-Osaka when transferring from a Shinkansen)

and get off at Kishibe Station.

(About 12 minutes)

When coming from Kyoto take a local train on

the same line in the Osaka direction.

(About 30 minutes)

(2) By Hankyu Railway

Take a Kyoto Line local train at Osaka Umeda Station and get off at Shojaku Station.

(About 20 minutes)

When coming from Kyoto,

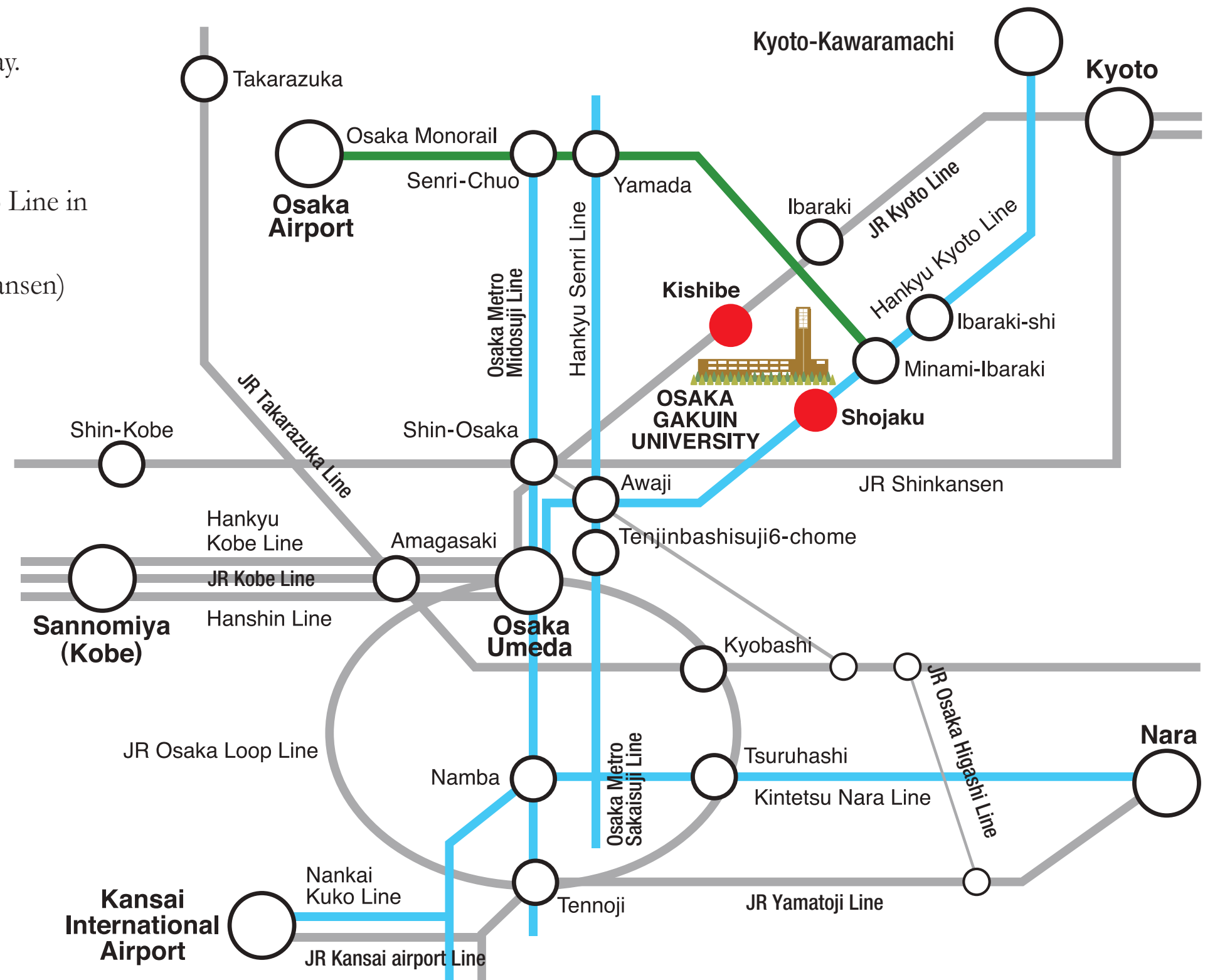
take the same train bound for

Osaka Umeda at Kyoto-Kawaramachi Station.

(About 40 minutes)

Note: Neither express nor semi-express trains stop at Kishibe or Shojaku Station.

From either station, it is about a 5-minute walk to the campus.



2. By Air

From Kansai International Airport, take

the JR limited express train named “Haruka”

bound for Kyoto at Kansai Airport Station and change trains at

Shin-Osaka Station. (About 80 minutes)
