Service Description

Arrangement of telephones and other equipment to provide a means of warning specific persons that are needed to deal with an emergency. The warning may be by a priority telephone message, a siren or other means.

Conditions of Service

1. A five year contract applies to all Central Office (C.O.) equipment.
2. Provided only in the Armstrong, Enderby, Kelowna, Lakeview Heights, Lumby, Mica Creek, Naramata, Okanagan Falls, Okanagan Mission, Oyama, Peachland, Penticton, Revelstoke, Rutland, Salmon Arm, Sicamous, Summerland, Tappen, Vernon, Westbank and Winfield exchanges.
3. Combinations of the various types of equipment described below may be utilized to serve the specific needs of the community.
4. The system is not available for new installations or off-premises moves. Present customers may add or change equipment on a recovery basis only.

Note 1: An annunciator panel may be furnished by the Company at an emergency reporting point at no charge other than termination charges. F

Note 2: The termination charge to be billed to the person subscribing for the alarm circuit terminating on the panel. Termination charges are in addition to standard distance measurement and service charges for alarm circuits.
