


Discovering Glory!

The just shall live by faith.




t was clearly shown to us.

"They are all gone aside, they are all together become filthy: there is none that doeth good, *no, not one.*" (Psalm 14:2-3 & Romans 3:10-18)


You work. You receive wages. You deserve your wages.

But people fail to realize that there are wages due for the sins that they do.


"For the wages of sin is death;..." (Romans 6:23)

Now we may be justified and free from the wages of sin, if we will also be as dead to sin with Christ and live with Him. He arose in victory over sin and death.




You have a decision to make.
