# 1. Paul <u>taught</u> and <u>demonstrated</u> the <u>equality</u> of all people throughout the New Testament.

 $^{"23}$  for all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God,  $^{24}$  and all are justified freely by his grace through the redemption that came by Christ Jesus."

~Romans 3:23-24~

- 2. This <u>teaching</u> on <u>women</u> and <u>children</u> would have been viewed as <u>radical</u> at that time.
- 3. <u>Cultures</u> that have been permeated by <u>Christian belief</u> are significantly <u>better</u> for women and children than those that have not been.

## The Ideal Family

- 1. Wives submit to their husbands.
- 2. Husbands <u>love</u> their wives and are not <u>harsh</u> with them.
- 3. Children obey their parents.
- 4. Fathers do not <u>embitter</u> or <u>exasperate</u> their children.

### How to embrace this ideal:

- 1. Identify the problem.
- 2. Do the <u>hard work</u> of getting to the <u>root</u> of the problem and <u>fixing</u> it.
