¹⁵ But on some points I have written to you very boldly by way of reminder, because of the grace given me by God ¹⁶ to be a minister of Christ Jesus to the Gentiles in the priestly service of the gospel of God, so that the offering of the Gentiles may be acceptable, sanctified by the Holy Spirit. Romans 15:17-21 shows how Paul's mission impacts his life:

2. Paul is clear that this is more than lip service.
3. Paul evaluates his progress.
