The Embassy of the United States of America presents its compliments to the Ministry of Foreign Affairs and International Cooperation of the Kingdom of Cambodia and has the honor to refer to the discussions between our two Governments regarding the status of the United States military personnel and civilian employees of the Department of Defense who may be temporarily present in Cambodia in connection with military assistance activities and other official duties. As a result of these discussions, the Embassy has the honor to propose that such personnel be accorded the same status as provided to the technical and administrative staff of the United States Embassy, and that they may enter and exit Cambodia with United States Government identification and with collective movement or individual travel orders.

The Embassy further proposes that the Royal Government of Cambodia accord duty-free treatment upon the importation or exportation as well as exemption from internal taxation of products, property, materials, or equipment imported or acquired in Cambodia by the United States Government in connection with military assistance activities and other official duties.

If the foregoing is acceptable to the Royal Government of Cambodia, the Embassy has the further honor to propose that this note, together with your reply, shall constitute an agreement between our two Governments effective from the date of your reply . A suggested response is enclosed.

The Embassy of the United States of America avails itself of this opportunity to renew to

the Ministry of Foreign Affairs and International Cooperation the assurances of its highest consideration.
