



Electrical Generation

- Pre-War 4,400 Megawatts (MW)
- 05 Oct 03 4,417 MW (Met initial goal of 4,400 MW)
- 01 Jun 04 6,000 MW (Estimated summer 2003 peak demand)
- Ambassador Bremer approved a new power increase plan on 14 Jan to prevent current project delays from impacting the goal of 6,000 MW by 01 Jun
- CPA Autumn Maintenance Program began Oct 03 transitioning to Spring Program during February resulted in about 879 MW currently in scheduled maintenance losses on average over the past week

Education

- International scholars in civic education from Czech Republic, Estonia, Egypt, Latvia, South Africa, and US shared their experience with Iraqis during a conference in Baghdad on civic education
- US State Department Fulbright Office added two new Fulbright Programs:

Health Care

- USAID delivered first of 600 Primary Heath Care Kits to Al Andalous Clinic in Ramadi (Al Anbar governorate)
- Kits contain medical supplies and equipment, office furniture, and laboratory equipment

fact sheet

- Al Andalous Clinic serves over 28,000 people and is being used to assess and modify the health care kit delivery process
- In February, 800 tons of high protein biscuits were delivered to 15 Governorates for distribution to malnourished children and pregnant and nursing mothers
- Ministry of Health (MOH) concluded 3 health forums in Baghdad to discuss health sector reform

Economics

- 2004 Tax Strategy signed and goes into effect 01 April
- The Iraqi Governing Council's Finance Committee adopted new Company Law and 2004 Trade Liberalization Policy
- Financial Management Information System (FMIS) went online on 16 Feb at the Ministry of Finance
- Baghdad stock exchange market will open in late February

Currency and Banking

- As of 20 Feb, Iraq's two large state-owned commercial banks, Rafidain and Rasheed, have extended dollar loans totaling \$8.9 million, a 49 percent increase over the dollar loan amount extended as of 30 Nov 2003
- Other Developments
- WTO on 11 Feb unanimously conferred "observer status" upon Iraq
- As of 19 Feb, Development Fund for Iraq (DFI) balance was \$8.4 billion
 - Total payments amount to \$4 billion
