Because our hope rests on a fact—"Christ has been raised from the dead"—we need not fear the heat, distress, or droughts that afflict us. In Christ, we will bear unfading fruit and share in his Resurrection.

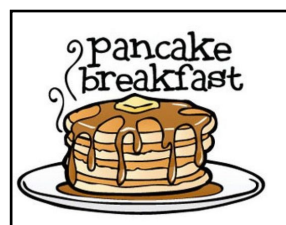
