

# Bunny in an Egg

## Materials:

Felt  
DMC thread  
Needle  
Scissors  
Polyfill  
Patterns

## Directions:

1. Use the patterns to cut out two of the bunny shape in white felt and two of the egg shape in felt.

2. Stitch the bunny's face on one side of the bunny. On the opposite piece sew on a white pompom for a tail. (Figure 1)

3. With the wrongs sides together sew your bunny together using a running stitch. Leave a small opening to stuff your bunny body with polyfill. Then stitch the body closed. (Figure 2)

4. Cut one of your felt egg pieces in half in a zigzag design to resemble a cracked egg. Using DMC stitch some designs to decorate your egg.(Figure 3)

5. Then stitch your egg pieces together using a running stitch. Leave the zigzag open so you can insert your bunny into the egg.

6. You're done! Now it's time to give your bunny and egg to somebunny special!
