Board Members

At tomorrow's meeting we will discuss of SB 1031 (Wiener) Regional Transportation Measure. A key part of this complex legislation concerns a ½ cent Sales Tax to raise revenue for transit and transportation in the nine Bay Area Counties.

As background information for the discussion, we are providing you with an estimate of the breakdown by county of the amount raised and the percentage each county is contributing on the proposed \$1 billion per year measure.

The first document shows the estimate and the second the basis of the estimate derived from the existing ¼ cent sales tax collected statewide.

This information is important to the discussion because of VTA's dependence on local sales taxes to support both operations and capital projects.

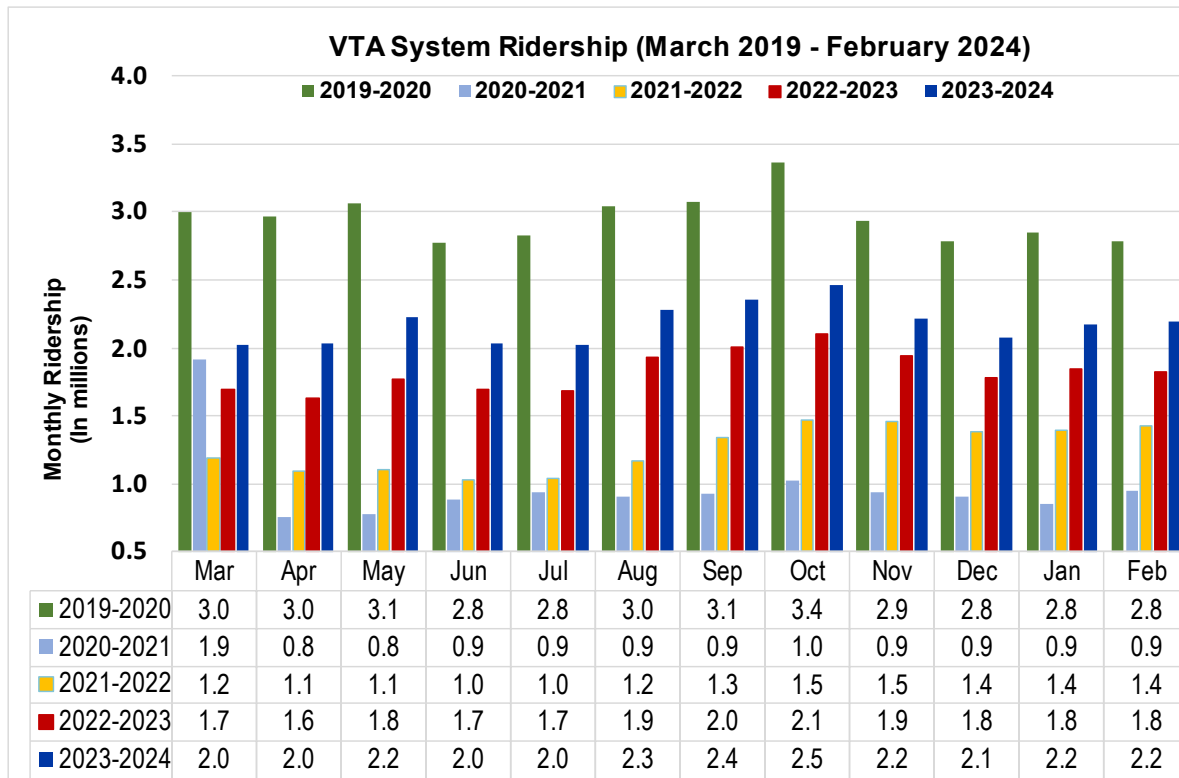
DISCUSSION:

February 2024 total monthly system ridership was 2,192,572, an increase of 20.3% over February 2023. The total monthly bus ridership was 1,817,041, an increase of 21.7% over February 2023. The total monthly light rail ridership in February 2024 was 375,531, an increase of 13.9% over February 2023. February 2024 monthly system ridership increased by 1.6% compared to January 2024. February 2024 system ridership (bus and light rail) is at about 77% of the New Transit Service Plan (NTSP) pre-pandemic benchmark.
