Under EYW project youth are also linked with different industries and markets so that they can be economically empowered.

International Youth Day is celebrated globally in the month of August. The purpose of celebrating international Youth day is to highlight youth issues and bring them into the attention of the global community and recognize the potential of youth as stakeholders in today's global society.



Celebration of International Youth Day was endorsed by United Nations General Assembly in December 1999. 12th August was announced as International Youth Day. Ever since then the International youth day has been globally.

He said after receiving this training youth will be able to earn from Rs.40000/ to Rs. 100000/month. He also stressed that there



is great demand of Pakistani labor in middle east, however same labor faces numerous problems when they are working in Pakistan due to lack of regulations.

At the end of the event **Mr. Sajid Ahmed**, Manager Archroma, Pakistan, Jamshoro and Vice President JCCI, said, I am thank full to all the dignitaries who took their time and joined us today. He also invited EYW youth to visit Archroma Pakistan, Jamshoro plant for an exposure visit. Mr. Sajid also announced cash reward of Rs. 20000 for youth wo maintain highest rate of survival of trees after six months.

The International Youth Day Celebration event was followed by launching of Clean and Green

Campaign. The campaign was launched by **Mr. Amjad Shaikh** SSP, Jamshoro. Mr. Shaikh planted a tree at the CPLC office which was followed by plantation by other guests and youth.
